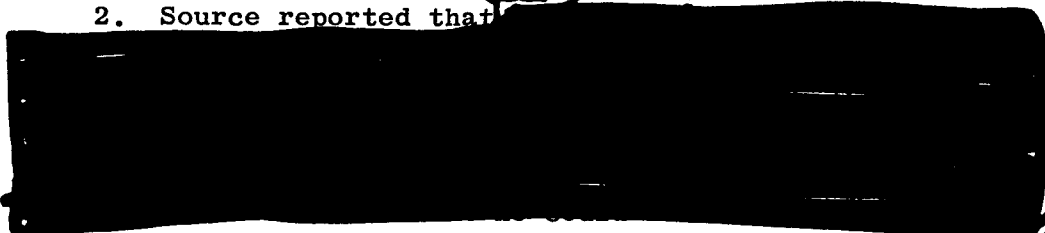

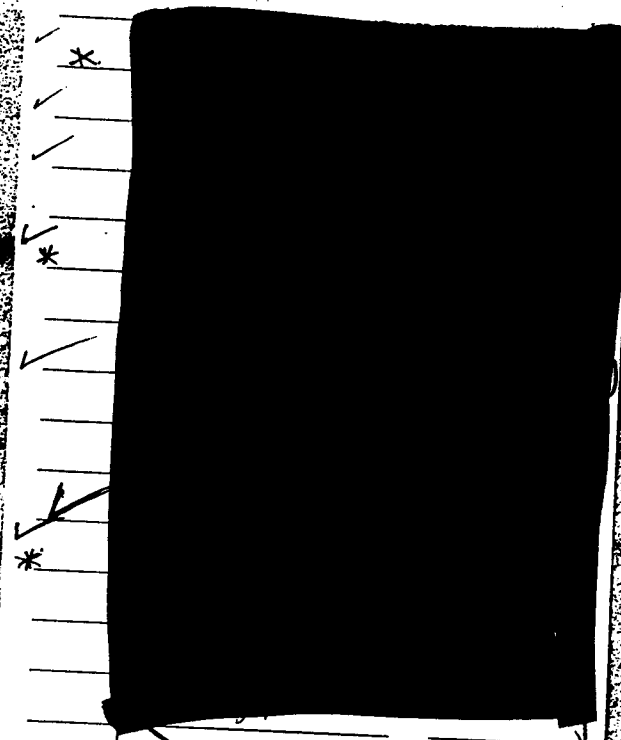

The NYO interviewed [redacted] in February, 1964, after his return from the Soviet Union. [redacted] was cordial but furnished no information of any value. Newark has pointed out that [redacted] is dominated by [redacted] and that he declined to take advantage of the Immunity Statute and has spurned approaches made through the use of an intermediary. While these facts are true, it appears that on the basis of information from Sammy [redacted] that [redacted] may still be utilized between Soviets and that he will undoubtedly use [redacted] as he has in the past in any espionage operation for the Soviets. (S) (u)

It is, therefore, felt that this case should not be closed based solely on the fact that no information can be obtained from [redacted] and that Newark should clear with Bureau before any recontact is made with [redacted]. (S) (u)

On attached memorandum from Mr. Branigan to you dated 3-4-64 summarizing the results of interviews of Nosenko during the week of 2-24/28, the Director noted that we should press all angles vigorously *(X)*

While originally it was contemplated we would only be able to interview Nosenko on four occasions prior to his taking a brief vacation, we were able to arrange with CIA to interview Nosenko daily during the period from 3-3 through 3-6. Considerable additional information has been obtained and we are pressing all angles vigorously. *(X) (u)*

Current plans are for CIA to permit Nosenko (in accordance with his request) to take a two to three-week vacation starting next week. On his return to Washington arrangements will be made for additional interviews to see that we obtain all pertinent information and resolve investigation instituted from his information as rapidly as possible. *(X) (u)*

2. With regard to paragraphs one and three of your memorandum, this Agency is reluctant to disseminate information from a source whom this Agency suspects is not a bona fide defector. An important factor in determining bona fides continues to be the evaluation placed upon the information by your Bureau in terms of the criteria set forth in our memorandum dated 5 March 1964, reference CSCI-

3. Another area of concern on our part is the present need to restrict to the narrowest possible circle those persons and agencies who are aware of this Agency's suspicions that SAMMY is a KGB plant.

However, to round out this picture, your Bureau's evaluations are needed and it is hoped that we can receive at least the preliminary results of the investigations you have conducted as soon as possible.

5. Regarding paragraph four of your memorandum, this Agency has provided your Bureau with all of the information [REDACTED] obtained from SAMMY. It is believed that [redacted] is identical with [redacted] who was previously brought to your attention in the case entitled [redacted]. Your attention is directed to our letter dated April 8, 1958, and your letter dated April 21, 1958 (CSCI) in that case.

For your additional information, the case involving [redacted] was interviewed in December, 1960, and in January and March, 1961. Enclosed is a copy of Los Angeles report dated March 30, 1961, containing the results of the interviews.

[redacted] was again interviewed with the use of the polygraph on June 6, 1961, and no indications of attempts to deceive were noted. [redacted] was last contacted on February 8, 1962, and advised that [redacted] had had no further contact with Soviet officials.

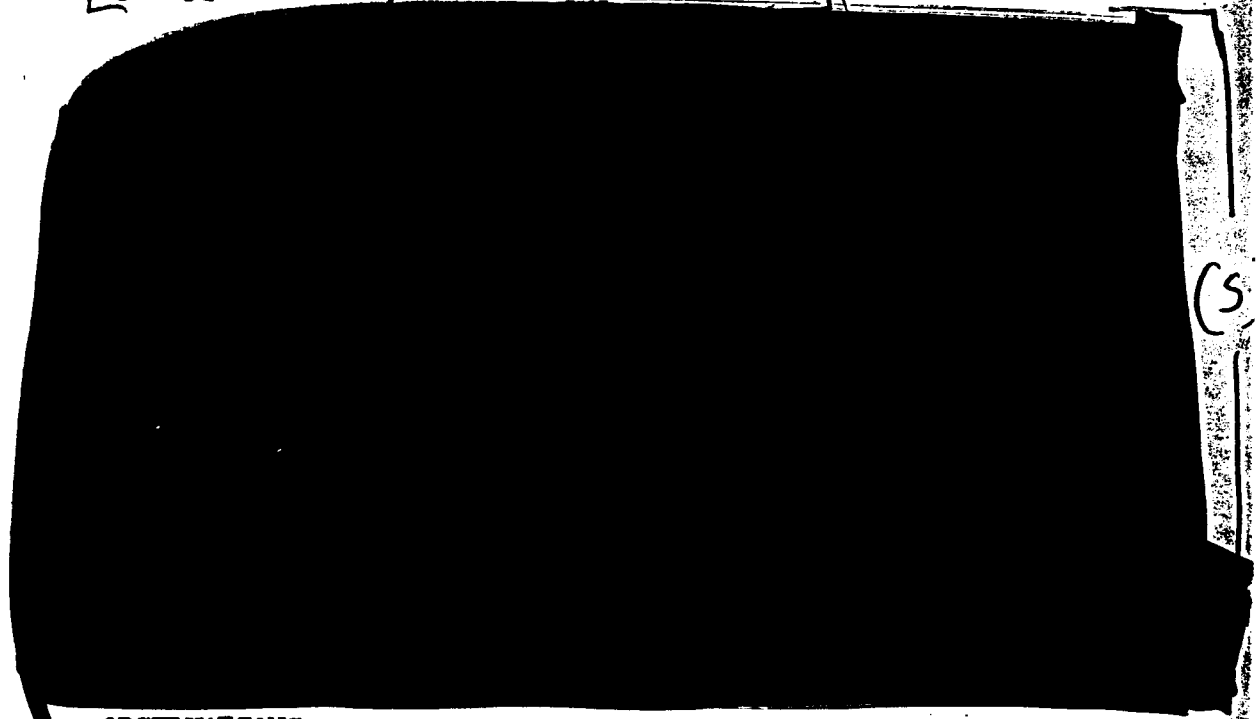
