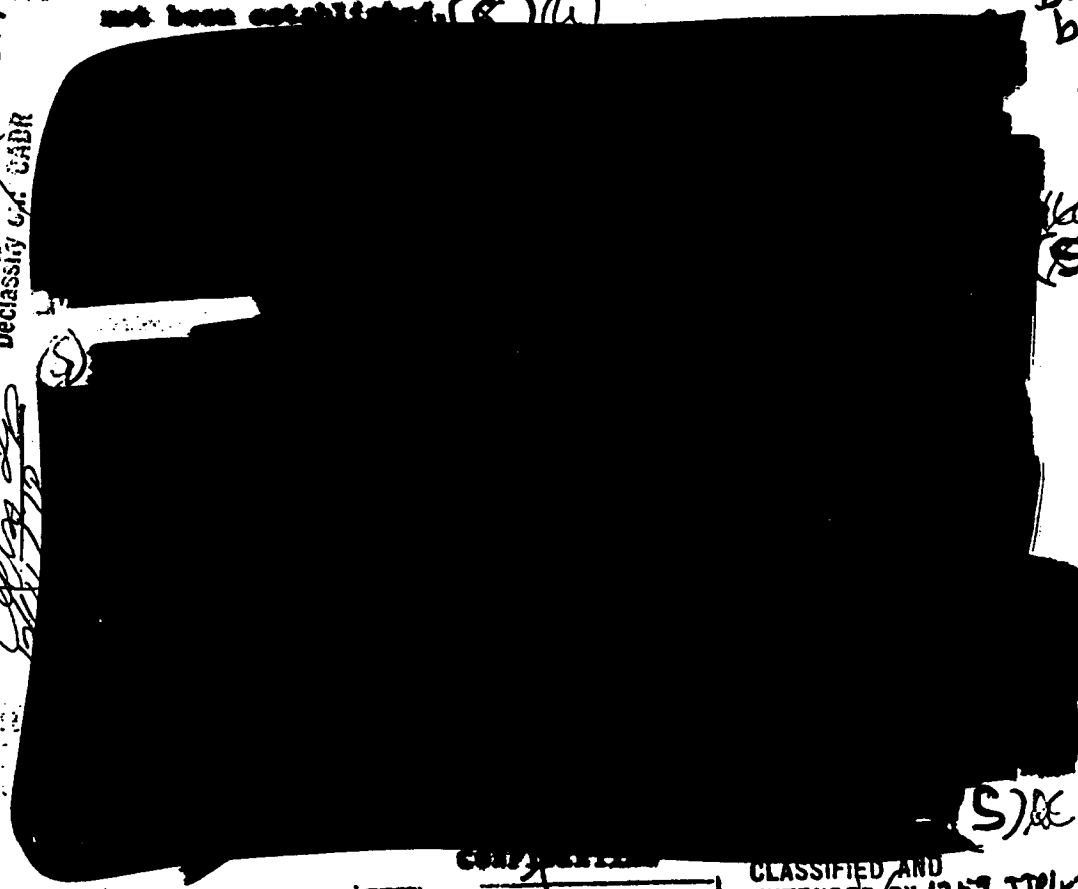

The information set forth hereinafter concerning captioned subjects was furnished on February 26, 1964 and April 2, 1964 to representatives of the Federal Bureau of Investigation by a confidential source who is a former experienced Soviet intelligence officer whose reliability has not yet been fully established. (S)(U)

During the course of interview, source was asked concerning [REDACTED] and advised that prior to the time of their arrival (1960) in the Soviet Union as [REDACTED] from the United States he had no knowledge of these individuals, and the Second Chief Directorate (counterintelligence) of the Committee for State Security (KGB) had no interest in them. Source advised that following the arrival of [REDACTED] in Moscow they came under the jurisdiction of the Second Chief Directorate since they were going to live in Paris. Source said [REDACTED]
