While CIA initially felt that subject would break during their interrogation, they also recognized the possibility that he might not and as of May 8th were inclined to believe that they might not be successful in breaking him based on current information.

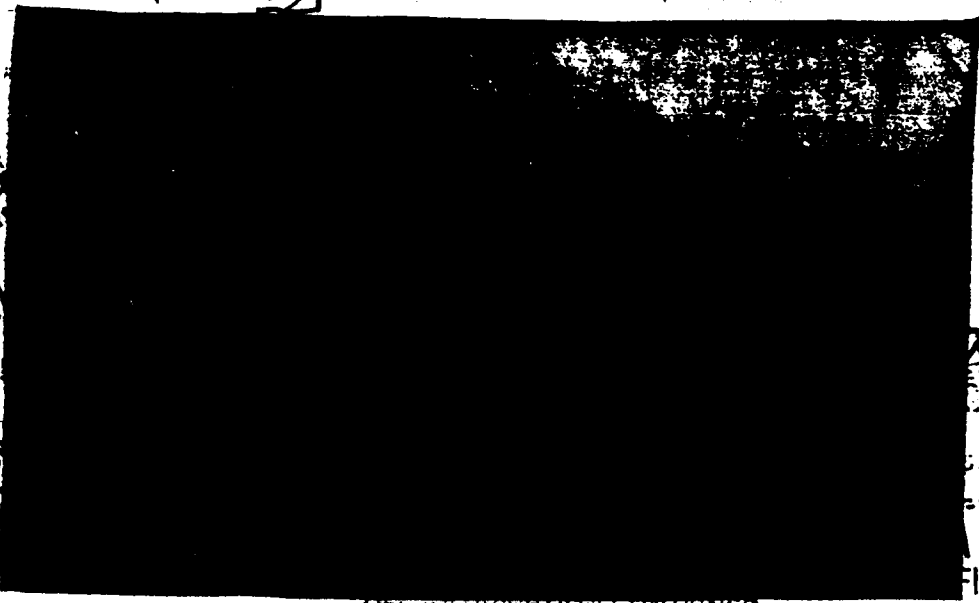

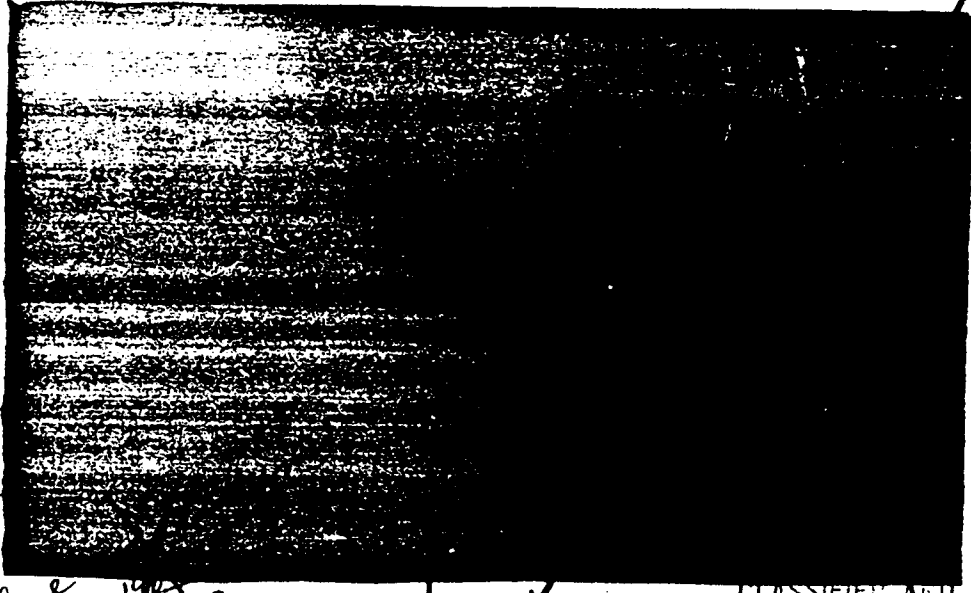

1. Transmitted herewith are four copies of a status report on the SAMMY case. As with the referent memorandum this report is an "in house" document loaned to your Bureau for background and may not be disseminated to other departments without the permission of this Agency.

2. The report describes action taken since the polygraph examination on 4 April, the kinds of information developed in the interrogations held since then, our evaluation of this information and of SAMMY as a personality, and finally our plans for further action.

3. Briefly, we still believe SAMMY to be a KGB plant and we think we have determined what portions of his personal history and KGB service bear directly on whatever KGB mission he has. However, we do not feel we can resolve the case unless [redacted]

Accordingly, no timetable for a final phase interrogation session can be projected until [redacted]

4. We are still interrogating SAMMY but in a non-hostile manner in order to maintain regular contact with him and to follow up on specific matters even though we recognize we are not getting information which can be accepted uncritically or given routine dissemination unless carefully worded caveats are used.
