In comparing the information reported in paragraph 3, above, with information on the same subject as previously reported by a sensitive source of your Bureau (your memoranda of 31 December 1962, 14 February 1963, 10 April 1963 and 14 October 1963, File number (E) 100-354839 Subject, Soviet Personnel Intelligence Activities) you will note that there are some basic similarities as well as a number of contrasting elements. We cannot, at this time, fully assess their significance.




