The documentation of Soviet nationals set out in LHM
was obtained from U. S. Department of State records as maintained
in NYO [REDACTED] (The exception being [REDACTED] and
[REDACTED] when documentation as furnished by [REDACTED]
subject was used. No record was found reflecting that Soviets
by these names had ever been in the U.S. (U)

Concerning [REDACTED] the person subject addressed
[REDACTED] did not reflect any
Soviet by that name ever in the U.S. The nearest similar name
was [REDACTED] Bureau file 105-16107, who was
in the U.S. from March, 1950 to May, 1954 as a Tass employee.
[REDACTED] photograph was exhibited to the subject during the
initial interview and she advised that the photo appeared
familiar and resembled that of [REDACTED] This photograph,
among others, was again displayed to the subject at the conclusion

of the interview on 7/17/64; however, she did not identify it nor would she state it resembled [redacted] when questioned about her earlier statement that it did resemble [redacted]. She stated that [redacted] was a very ordinary looking RUSSIAN with no outstanding features and in all fairness could not definitely state that this photograph did resemble [redacted]. She did recall that [redacted] remarked that he was never in the U.S., however, he would like to visit the U.S. very much.

It is interesting to note that [redacted] could possibly be identical with [redacted] based on the following:

1. [redacted] is very similar to [redacted] with the letters deleted.
2. Subject, upon first review of [redacted] photograph advised it resembled [redacted].
3. Subject instructed [redacted].
4. [redacted] is a derivative of [redacted].
5. No indication of a (Soviet national) by the name of [redacted] ever being in the U.S.
6. [redacted] recruited the subject and if he is in fact [redacted] he would be the logical one to supervise her activities and therefore be the recipient of her letters.
7. [redacted] as described by subject, fits the description of [redacted] as to age, hair, and height.

NYO indices reflect a file entitled, [redacted] Bufile 105-105228. A review of this file definitely establishes that this subject is [redacted].

It reflects that on 12/12/64 [redacted] and [redacted] CIA representatives, were engaged in passing a letter to [redacted] while she was in New York City with a dance group. The NYO was requested to observe her when she departed the U.S. to see if she gave a signal "by rubbing her eyes." [redacted]
