Reference is made to our letter dated September 10, 1964, which furnished information received by a confidential informant of this Bureau from an official of the KGB (Committee of State Security) New York Residency. This same informant has furnished the following information:

Prior to the defection of Sammy, there was a great deal of "closeness" between personnel of the First and Second Main Directorates of the KGB in Moscow. The informant said that the practice was for employees of the First Main Directorate going abroad to receive three months' training in the Second Main Directorate before going to the country of assignment. In this manner, employees of both Directorates became acquainted and, accordingly, were in a position to identify each other as KGB personnel.

The informant said the defection of Sammy caused a change in this procedure and that liaison between the two Directorates is now carried on only at the "Chief" level. The informant said that personnel of the First Department of the First Main Directorate and personnel of the Scientific Directorate spend a period of one month in training with the Seventh Directorate before coming to the U. S. on assignment. In this way, training is afforded in order to acquaint these employees with the methods used by the U. S. in maintaining physical surveillances.
