SAMMY is CIA's name for Yuri Nosenko, Soviet Committee for State Security (KGB) officer who defected to the United States and who CIA believes is a Soviet plant. In connection with further analysis of this matter and related cases, including our sensitive informant [redacted] CIA has requested a conference with Bureau representatives including New York representatives directly concerned with the handling of [redacted] and it is recommended that this conference be held 9-30-64.

CIA firmly believes that Nosenko is a Soviet plant and has been interviewing him intensively over a period of months in hopes of securing admissions from him that he is part of a Soviet deception effort. So far, they have not been successful in obtaining any such admissions from him. CIA has also been analyzing information received from many other sources, some of whom they feel are also Soviet plants and has analyzed information received from us obtained from our investigations and from various sources. They have noted that considerable information furnished by [redacted] has, in effect, supported statements made by Nosenko and have asked to confer concerning this matter.

It is noted that SAC Schmit, New York Office, is personally acquainted with [redacted] and he, with Supervisor [redacted] also thoroughly familiar with [redacted] information, will be at the Bureau attending the Internal Security-Espionage Conference on 9-28 and 29, 1964. It is believed it would be beneficial for the Bureau for us to have them held over and participate in a conference with CIA on 9-30-64. By so doing, we would be fulfilling CIA's request and it is believed that such a conference would be of value to the Bureau as we could determine what progress CIA has made in their interrogation of Nosenko.

2. SAMMY has identified Vladimir ALEKSANDROV as the artist and KGB agent who presented the seal with the concealed microphone to the United States Ambassador in the late 1940's. ALEKSANDROV is an agent of the First Section (United States Embassy), First Department (American), Second Chief Directorate, KGB. He has been a frequent visitor to Spasso House for many years and was acquainted with former Ambassador THOMPSON's wife, who visited him in his apartment to see his work.

3. SAMMY learned of ALEKSANDROV, whom he has never met, from Petr Ivanovich MASSYA, who until 1962 was ALEKSANDROV's KGB case officer. SAMMY does not know his current case officer.

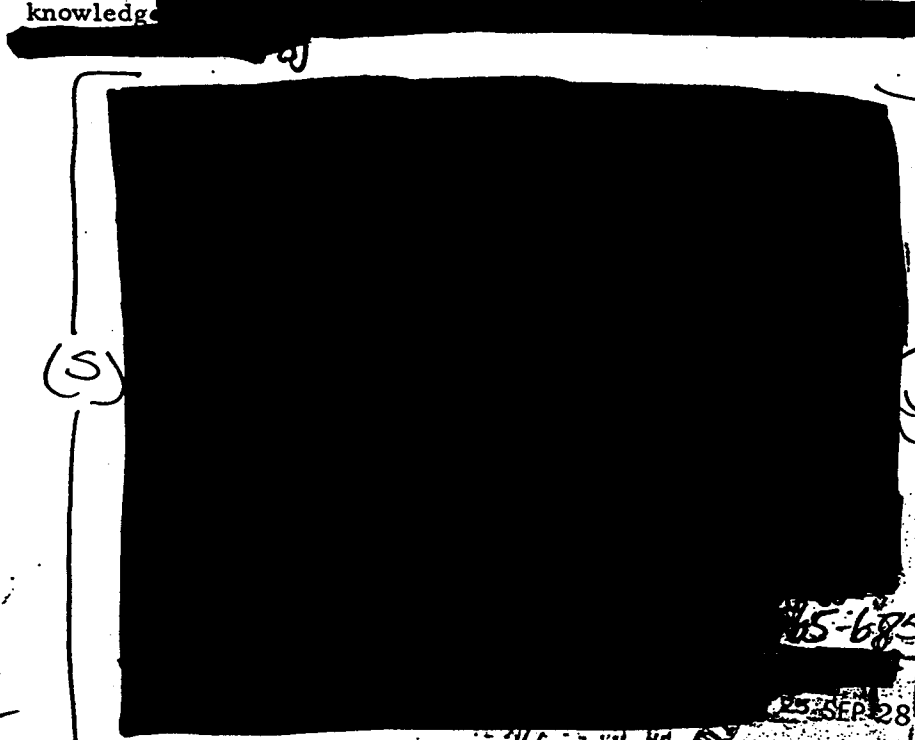

1. Reference is made to your memorandum dated 4 September 1964, Subject: [REDACTED]
2. SAMMY did not know that [REDACTED] when informed of this, SAMMY conjectured that the First Chief Directorate would certainly take advantage of this opportunity to use [REDACTED] from the United States for transshipment to Soviet Bloc countries.

3. Concerning the actual recruitment of [REDACTED] SAMMY stated that [REDACTED] was recruited only because he happened to be in the USSR and there was an opportunity to recruit him. He was initially spotted by the local KGB in Odessa which reported the possibility of recruiting [REDACTED] to the Second Chief Directorate in Moscow. After learning that [REDACTED] was coming to Moscow the Second Chief Directorate instructed the Odessa KGB to put a case officer in contact with [REDACTED] but not to recruit him. An officer of the Second Chief Directorate, probably Yuriy Georgiyevich GRECHMANOV, Chief of the Second Section, Seventh Department, then checked with the First Chief Directorate to see whether or not they were interested in having [REDACTED] recruited. The First Chief Directorate indicated that they were interested in [REDACTED] because of his contacts who included [REDACTED] and a [REDACTED]. As far as SAMMY knows the subject of [REDACTED] dealings in electronic equipment was not mentioned. [REDACTED] was then recruited in Moscow by the Odessa KGB case officer who had come to Moscow and by either GRECHMANOV or [REDACTED].

[redacted] returned from abroad on September 20, 1964, and was interviewed on September 22, 1964. During this interview, photographs of the following individuals were displayed to [redacted]: (S)(U)

1. Sammy

After viewing the above photographs, [redacted] advised that none of these individuals were known to him. He was pointedly questioned as to whether any of these individuals were officers of the KGB (Committee of State Security) who interrogated him in the Soviet Union in 1962 after his compromise. He denied categorically that any of these individuals were the KGB officers involved. Moreover, he volunteered to take a Polygraph examination in this matter of identification. (S)(U)

[redacted] was also questioned concerning information in the extracts contained from tape transcriptions which were furnished to this bureau by letter dated March 11, 1964. (S)(U)

In this regard, it will be recalled that when [redacted] initially furnished information concerning his compromise in Sochi, USSR, in August, 1962, he described his compromise by stating that he was drugged and that his clothes were ripped from him, during which time photographs were taken of this scene.

When questioned regarding the young blond homosexual [redacted] that [redacted] engaged in voluntary homosexual acts, he advised as follows: (S) (u)

He stated that in 1960, he met a young blond male at the beach in Sochi, USSR, who claimed he was with the theater in Moscow. This individual, whose name he recalled as [redacted] made many anti-Soviet remarks, and seemed to favor the American way of life. [redacted] said they spent several days together at the beach and they enjoyed one another's company. [redacted] admitted that one evening, prior to his departure from Sochi in 1960, he and [redacted] went to a dark section in a park where [redacted] performed an unnatural oral act upon him. He added that this was the only homosexual activity he engaged in with [redacted] in 1960. (S) (u)

Regarding the foregoing, [redacted] stated that he is positive that no photographs could have been taken of this incident due to the extreme darkness of the park (S) (u)

[redacted] advised that he returned to Sochi, USSR, in 1961, and met a short dark male at the beach. They discussed the theater and the discussion revolved around whether or not this individual was acquainted with a man in the theater by the name of [redacted]. The unidentified individual told [redacted] he knew [redacted] and as a matter of fact [redacted] would be arriving in Sochi momentarily. [redacted] stated a few days later [redacted] met him on the beach in Sochi, and because [redacted] was leaving Sochi, [redacted] and the above unidentified male arranged a farewell party for [redacted] at [redacted] hotel in Sochi. The subject is the Soviet KGB (Committee for State Security) officer who defected to CIA in Switzerland in February, 1964. You previously have been informed that CIA is convinced that he is a plant. There is set forth herewith for the Bureau's guidance, a summary of information collected by the Liaison Agent from conversations with James Angleton, James Hunt, and David Murphey, all of CIA.

(1) CIA is continuing its interrogation of Nosenko. The agency officers involved still hold to the conclusion that the subject is a plant. Nosenko is confined to a safehouse as he has been since May of this year. He has not been permitted to leave the building and all precautions have been taken to prevent him from communicating with anybody outside of the safehouse. He has no access to publications including newspapers and has not been permitted to have a radio.
