1. Reference is made to your memorandum dated 14 July 1964, Subject: [REDACTED] INTERNAL SECURITY - R.

(S) 2. On 24 September 1964 SAMMY was shown a photograph of [REDACTED] which he was unable to identify. SAMMY initially stated that the name [REDACTED] was not familiar to him, but after hearing a short version of [REDACTED] experiences in the USSR as reported in reference he stated that he believed that he recalled hearing [REDACTED] name in 1960. SAMMY then said that he is certain that he heard this name in 1960 and that the Second Section, First Department, Second Chief Directorate, KGB, had some operational activity going on around him. SAMMY cannot recall the type of activity, knows none of the details, and is unable to provide the name of the case officer. SAMMY stated, however, that the following officers must have participated in this case in one way or another: Vladimir Ivanovich PETROV, Chief of the Second Section, First Department, Second Chief Directorate, KGB, Ivan Kuzmich REDOKIN, case officer of the Second Section, First Department, Second Chief Directorate, KGB, and Vadim (mnr) UDILOV, then a senior case officer of the Third Section, First Department, Second Chief Directorate, KGB, and currently an advisor to the Bulgarian Service. SAMMY is unable to provide any other details concerning [REDACTED]

3. SAMMY could not identify [REDACTED] the Soviet female involved with [REDACTED] either by name or by physical description. [REDACTED]

1. Further examination of subject case has revealed a peripheral involvement with operational activity in Moscow in October 1963. The details of this involvement follow:

A Soviet Air Force officer, believed to be a lieutenant colonel, approached two American newsmen on a flight from Moscow to Alma Ata on 6 October 1963. The Soviet appeared the following day at the Graphic Arts Exhibit, and asked to be put in touch with the American Embassy in Moscow, preferably with the American Air Attache. The newsman, who was present at the Exhibit at this time, stated he could not assist in such a matter. The Soviet then provided his name and address, and in return asked for the newsman's Moscow address and telephone number, which were given. The Soviet departed, stating that he intended to return to the Exhibit on or about 20 October 1963.

2. The Ambassador was advised of this encounter and

3. [REDACTED] subsequently reported that he either did not recognize the Soviet from the description provided, or the Soviet failed to put in an appearance at the Exhibit site in Alma Ata.

1. Reference is made to your letter of 10 September 1964, Subject: [redacted] and to our CSCI- [redacted] dated 19 August 1964, Subject: SAMMY.

2. Source was re-interviewed concerning [redacted] on 30 September 1964. When asked how he learned about [redacted] visits to the Soviet Union (which Source had earlier stated he thought took place in 1960 and 1961), Source replied that he was not sure when [redacted] had come to the Soviet Union, but that it was while Source was in the 7th Department.

3. When it was mentioned to Source that [redacted] had returned to the Soviet Union in 1962, Source stated that Yuriy Mikhaylovich DVORKIN of the 7th Department was still the case officer at that time and that he maintained a file on [redacted]. Source stated that there was no plan to recruit [redacted] but only to study him as being possibly an agent or an operational contact of [redacted]. Source was aware of [redacted] visit to Odessa, which he thought was for the purpose of visiting relatives who lived there. Source stated that DVORKIN instructed the Odessa KGB to surround [redacted] with agents to watch his behavior. If there had been any indication uncovered that [redacted] was engaged in intelligence activity, he would have been arrested and an approach made to him on this basis. However, the coverage of him revealed nothing pertinent. Source does not know any details of the agent activity around [redacted] in Odessa, but stated that there was no operational approach made to him.

It is therefore requested that the Bureau consider contacting CIA for the purpose of clarifying SAMMY's use of code names [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in conjunction with [REDACTED]. (S) A significant omission has been noted during various interviews with SAMMY. SAMMY in interview of 8/10/64, contends that he was in 1959, the Deputy Chief of the Section (7th Dept.) which worked against tourists from the US, Canada, Britain and the Commonwealth. SAMMY stated that he never read [REDACTED] file although he had to know about everything in the section if the Section Chief was away. In interviews conducted, SAMMY mentions the fact that [REDACTED] served in the US Army during the war and that he had something to do with intelligence. New York believes that if SAMMY had any working knowledge of the [REDACTED] matter he would have been cognizant of the fact that [REDACTED] had served in the US Air Force from [REDACTED] and further that he would have mentioned this fact during interview since this military service is [REDACTED] alleged [REDACTED]. 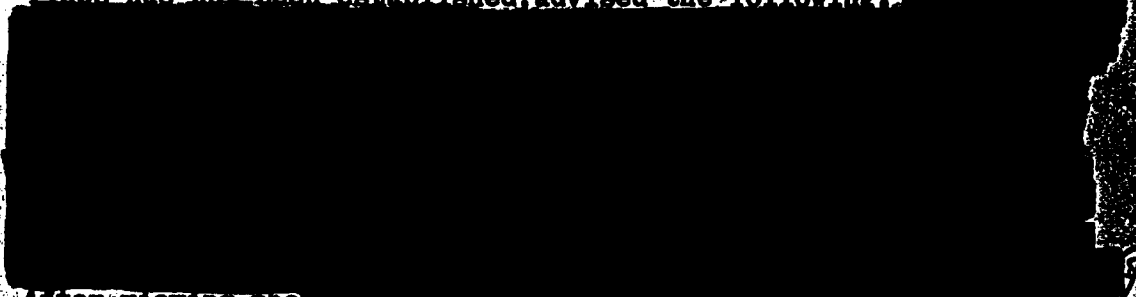
