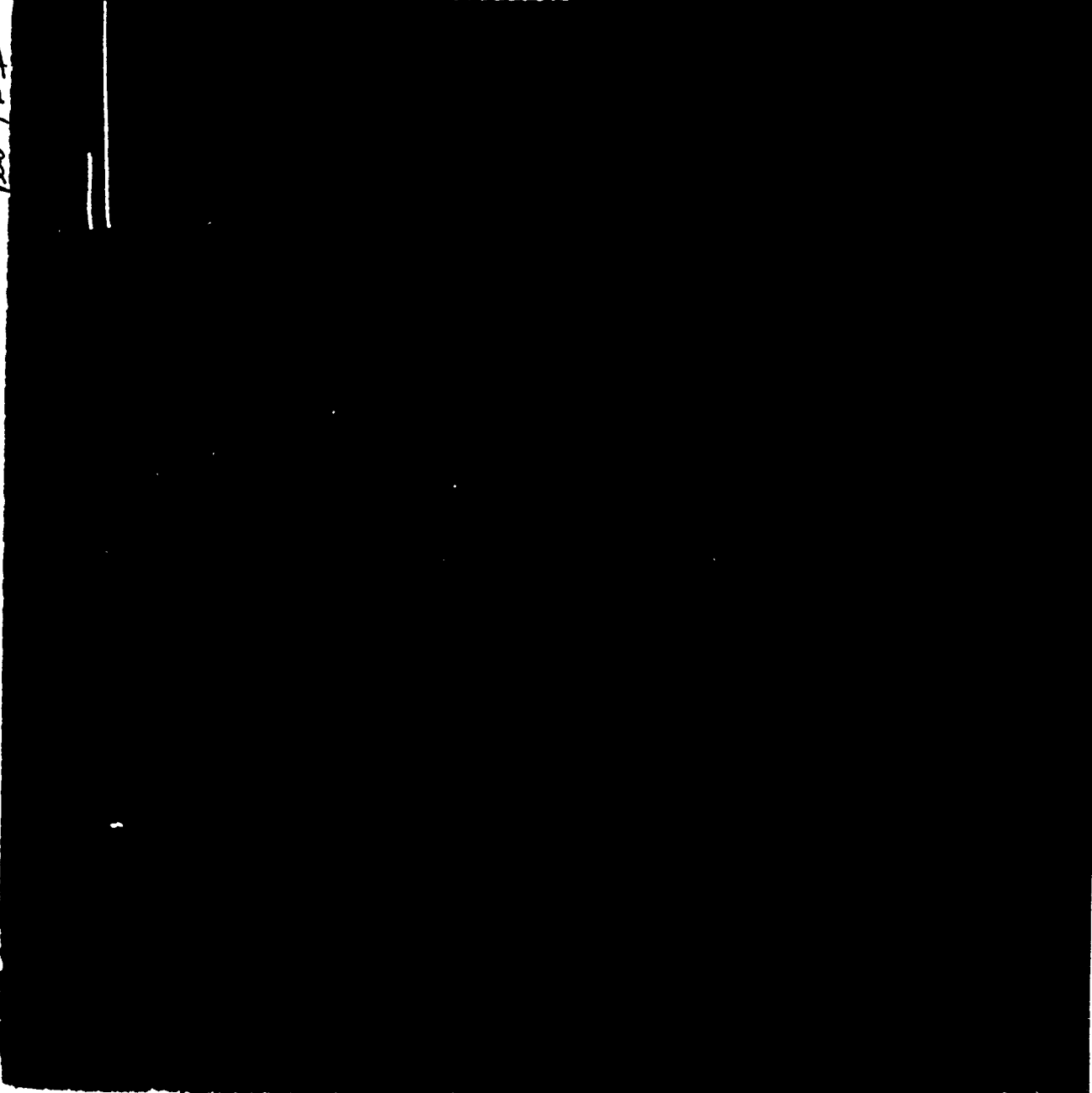

While talking about this matter, informant laughed and said that YURI NOSENKO knows many of the chiefs and deputies of the KGB directorates and departments at KGB headquarters in Moscow, and it might be hard to find chiefs to serve abroad if the criteria is based on whether or not YURI NOSENKO knows such individuals. He pointed out that in the KGB headquarters in Moscow there are four separate dining rooms for personnel who work in headquarters. He said one such dining room is reserved only for chiefs and deputies of departments. Because of this fact, according to the informant, NOSENKO has a vast knowledge of the hierarchy of KGB.



Informant's Comments Concerning YURI  
NOSENKO, ANATOLI GOLITZYN, and PETR  
DERJABIN

Informant remarked that at the present time no one in KGB quarters, to his knowledge, is talking about YURI NOSENKO. Informant said that in the recent past he has chatted with many of the KGB employees of the NY Residency concerning NOSENKO, but said that no one appears to know where NOSENKO is at the present time or what he is doing. The general consensus of opinion among KGB employees in NY is that in the future KGB will be feeling sharply the effects of NOSENKO's "escape" to American intelligence authorities.

Informant said that based on these general conversations with other KGB personnel, he has gotten the impression that NOSENKO is considered to be vastly more important than either ANATOLI GOLITZYN or PETR DERJABIN, two Soviet nationals who have also defected to American intelligence authorities in the past.

Informant said that this opinion appears to be based on several factors, each of which has a great deal of validity. Informant remarked that NOSENKO, first of all, worked against personnel stationed at the American Embassy in Moscow, and stated that with NOSENKO's help agents were developed among these Americans working in the embassy. Secondly, informant said that it is assumed by KGB personnel that because of this closeness to the American Embassy in the past, NOSENKO would also be familiar with the number of microphones which had been installed in the American Embassy by KGB and the locations of these microphones.

Thirdly, informant said that NOSENKO, as a deputy to a chief in a department of the Second Directorate, would normally have had access to a telephone directory listing all personnel in all directorates of KGB in Moscow. Informant said that another factor which is a formidable one in the minds of other KGB employees is that NOSENKO travelled in a rather influential circle of friends in Moscow who were high in the Soviet Government. Informant said that this fact is generally attributable to the influence of NOSENKO's father, who had formerly been a Deputy to NIKITA KHRUSHCHEV.

Informant said that it appeared to him that no one in KGB in NY could properly evaluate at this time the future effects of NOSENKO's defection. He said he was passing this information along to interviewing agents merely to convey to them a general impression of the thinking of KGB employees in NY regarding the NOSENKO defection and its future importance to KGB.
