On 1/27/65, James Hunt, CIA, furnished the following to the Liaison Agent: (u)

Senator Dirksen recently communicated with [redacted] advising that one of his constituents, [redacted] wrote to the Senator and inquired concerning the whereabouts of the subject. CIA has replied to Dirksen informing him that Nosenko is residing in the U. S. and is cooperating with U. S. authorities. (u)

Hunt stated that the inquiry levied on the Senator possibly was coming from some curious individual who followed the publicity previously given to Nosenko. CIA nevertheless does not wish to discount the possibility that there may be more to this inquiry and the Agency has requested that the Bureau endeavor to conduct an appropriate check on this matter; namely, to determine the purpose of [redacted] request. (u)

Pursuant to instructions, the Liaison Agent requested James Hunt, CIA, on 2/5/65, to furnish the Bureau the copy of the correspondence received by Senator Dirksen from [redacted]. There is enclosed herewith a copy of a letter dated 1/11/65, which was received by Dirksen, together with a copy of a letter which Dirksen had sent to the State Department concerning this matter. 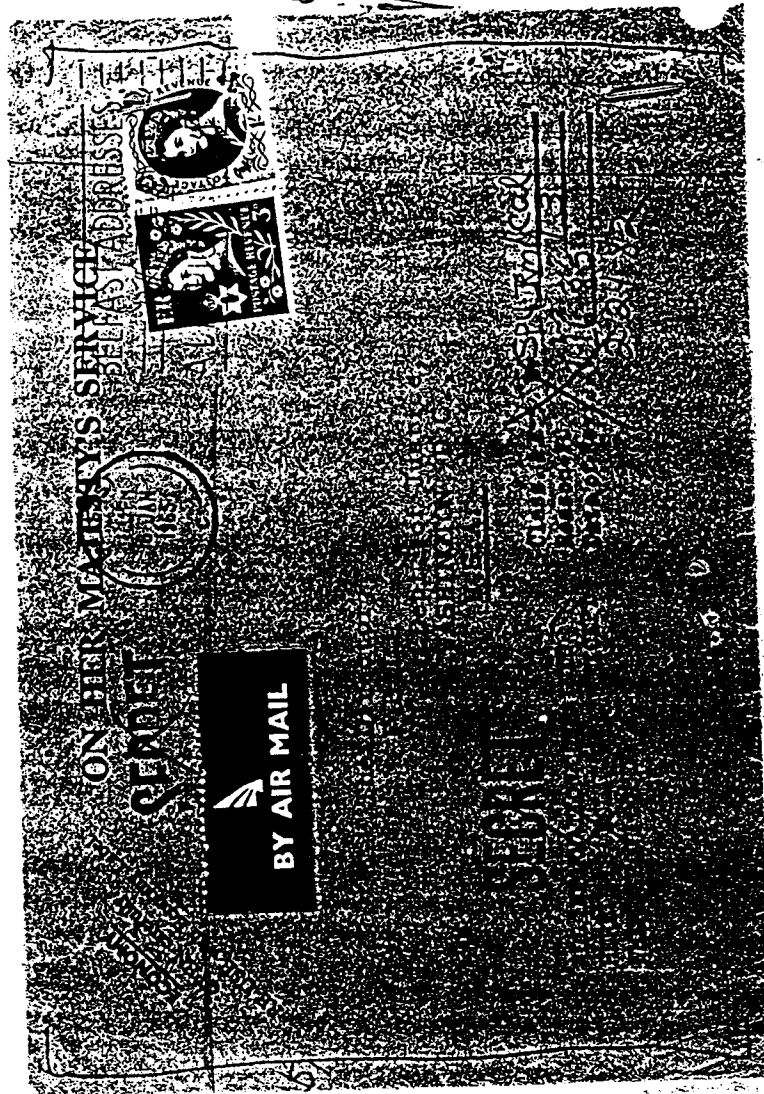
