The subject is the KGB defector whom the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) considers to be a plant. You may be interested in the following comments which were volunteered to the Liaison Agent on 7/24/65, by Dave Murphy, head of the Soviet Russia desk in CIA.

Murphy advised that he and others in CIA who have been deeply involved in evaluating all of Nosenko's material are completely convinced that Nosenko is definitely a plant. Murphy stated that his people have reviewed and re-examined the CIA position and all people have categorically come up with the same finding; namely, that Nosenko is engaged in a Soviet directed deception operation.

Murphy confided that CIA is still talking to Nosenko and would continue to do so. The subject is still confined in a house in Maryland not too far from the District of Columbia. He has not been permitted to communicate to anybody outside of CIA. He has been given some reading material but has no radio or television. He is in good health and, although he periodically goes into a tantrum, CIA doctors have pronounced him as being physically and mentally fit.
