It is observed here that interview of NOSENKO was discontinued 4/3/64, upon the insistance of CIA, just two months after his defection, and only ten interviews were

completed.

On the basis of the few cases in which both sources have furnished information it must be concluded NOSENKO has given more detailed and more accurate data. This is explainable to some extent at least by the fact these cases, or most of them, were instances where invaded the special are them, were instances where invaded the special area of NOSENKO's knowledge, observed. Many among all the cases lumbered by are based on fragmentary recollections and are hardly susceptible

Also, if this is true there is little purpose in comparison of his accuracy and volume with that of

This communication is written on the premise that SAMMY was an officer of the SCD and is an authentic defector regardless of his various personal faults and weaknesses of character. It is felt there is very good chance that this position is also the true situation. The cases furnished by NOSENKO while not transcendent actually compare very favorably
