Nosenko is a Soviet intelligence officer who defected in Switzerland on February 4, 1964, and is under the custody and control of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) and it assigned him the code name "Sammy." CIA has advised through liaison that voluminous additional material will be furnished to the Bureau in this case which, because of its extreme sensitivity, will be sent under a new code name [redacted]. It is being handled on a strict, need-to-know basis both at CIA and the Bureau. (S)(u)

The new material will require extensive study in conjunction with previous material in this file. In view of the sensitivity of this matter and to permit ready access to the file, it is recommended it be maintained on an indefinite basis in Room 828, 9th & D Building where it will be under the control of the case supervisor. It is further recommended that arrangements be made with the Records Section to have one employee of that Section be responsible for handling of the mail in connection with serialization, indexing, and filing. 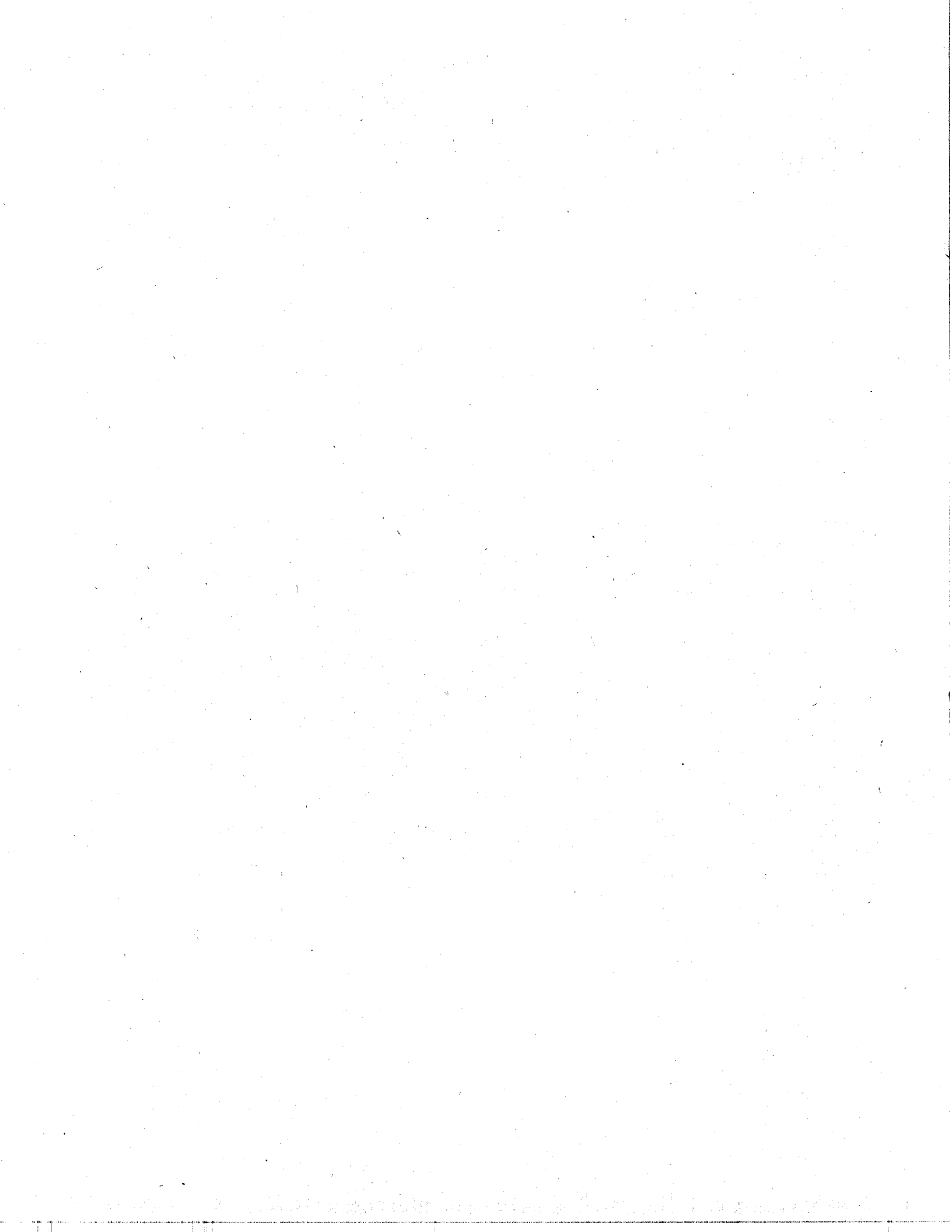

With regard to the Nosenko study furnished to the Bureau by the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) on February 19, 1968, Agents Cregar and [redacted] have developed the following information which should be kept in mind when reviewing and analyzing the material provided by CIA: *b7c per [redacted]*

The referenced study was an extremely controversial document within CIA during the period of its preparation and final publication. The Office of Security within the Agency questions the validity and reliability of the material used for the presentation of some of the conclusions. Within CIA some people have taken the position that the interrogation of Nosenko was improperly handled, and he definitely was not debriefed in detail. Charges have also been made that the output from Nosenko was never thoroughly analyzed. The Office of Security is currently engaged in an intensive interrogation of Nosenko which will include a reexamination of all items previously discussed with the subject and will also cover some new areas. *[redacted]*

We, therefore, should accept the referenced study as an interim document. *(u)*

Reference is made to the conference between representatives of WFO and the Domestic Intelligence Division on 1/17/68, during which WFO representatives were furnished with five volumes of material in captioned matter and instructed to establish contact with Mr. BRUCE SOLIE of CIA.

After reviewing the material received in this matter, SA [REDACTED] contacted Mr. SOLIE on 1/22/68. At that time arrangements were made for informal delivery to Mr. SOLIE of memoranda prepared by WFO and photographs, where pertinent, to be used by SOLIE in this matter. It was agreed that [REDACTED] would be questioned concerning this material and the results thereof would be included in the transcripts covering interview, copies of which would be furnished to the Bureau through liaison. It was agreed that this arrangement would reduce to a minimum the paper work involved and would expedite WFO's assistance to SOLIE in connection with these interviews.

Since 1/22/68, SA [REDACTED] has maintained contact with SOLIE and WFO has prepared 21 memoranda, 16 of which have been delivered to SOLIE together with pertinent photographs. 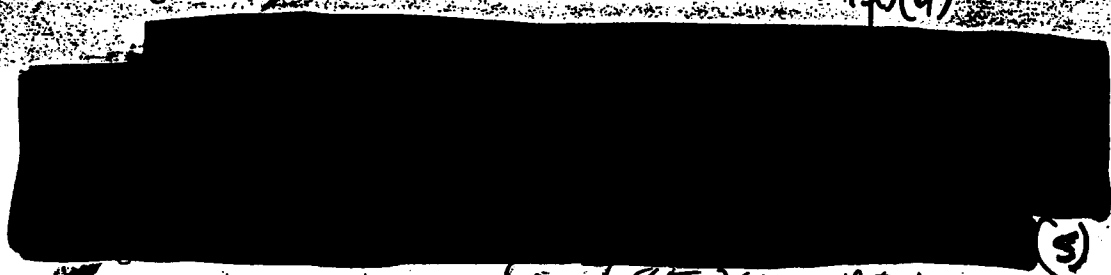

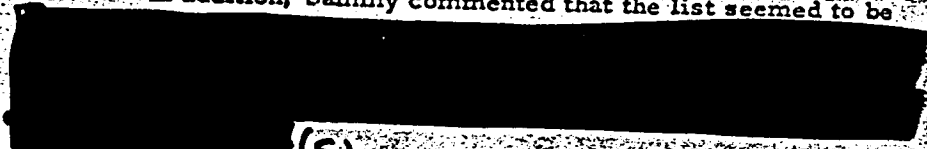
