1. Reference is made to Operational Memoranda # N-229 and # N-229-A, both dated 9 December 1968. Both of the above memoranda contain written remarks by Source concerning [REDACTED]

2. To assist the reader in a review of the above information, attached is a copy of a 2 October 1964 memorandum to the FBI. The attachment to the 2 October 1964 memorandum was a detailed report of remarks by Source in 1964 on many of the individuals mentioned in Operational Memoranda 229 and 229-A. The U. S. Embassy has a Section called the Miscellaneous Services section which performs, i. e. arranges to have done, a multitude of miscellaneous personal services for Embassy personnel - from laundry and dry cleaning to repair of shoes, watches, etc., to assisting in locating odd or unusual items an Embassy employee might want to buy. In addition, this office serves as a ticket bureau: all tickets for domestic intercity transportation within the USSR and all tickets for transportation from the USSR abroad must be procured through this office. Also, while technically Embassy personnel are free to obtain local theater, concert, etc. tickets themselves, this is a very complex and time-consuming operation and in practice almost all entertainment tickets are obtained by Embassy personnel through the Miscellaneous Services office. In all these functions, this office serves de facto as a sort of branch of UPRK.

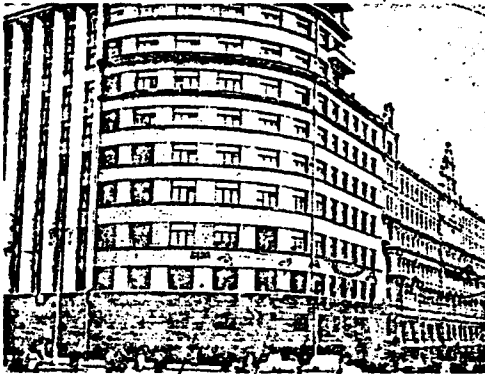

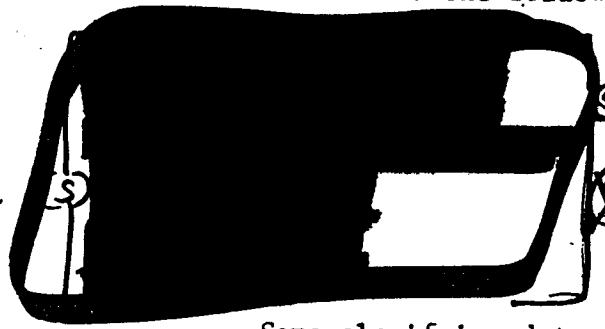

1. Reference is made to Operational Memo #N-237 of 23 December 1968 to which was attached a hand written memorandum prepared by Source concerning the discovery of "dead drops" by the KGB. In Item 3 of this memorandum, Source made reference to a water tank of a man's room in a garden behind Zubovskaya Square opposite a military academy where a dead drop was found by chance in 1959. According to Source, the contents of the drop revealed that an engineer or an official connected with the air or rocket industry must be a Soviet spy.

2. In an interview which took place on 23 December 1961, DS-2137 told us that an American tourist guide was seen to meet a Soviet employee of a scientific research office in Moscow, who worked on rocket missile fuel in a very Top Secret office. The KGB placed the Soviet under supervision and established that the American was evidently in intelligence and that this was an agent contact. According to DS-2137, the incident occurred at the end of 1959, or the beginning of the 1960 tourist season, as he heard of the incident in July 1960. The tourist referred to by DS-2137 has not been identified.
