1. The undersigned was in contact with Source on 15 May 1968, but there was not a formal interview.

2. In some conversation which occurred during recreation, Source made certain casual remarks of interest. The undersigned asked Source about how many interpreters there were in Intourist and Source estimated that there were perhaps three hundred interpreters in the Anglo-American Department of Intourist. In addition to the regular interpreters, there were, according to Source, additional employees during the summer, many of whom had seasonal employment such as teachers.

3. Source estimated that perhaps 90 per cent of the above interpreters were women and also stated that there were perhaps 130 interpreters employed in the section of Intourist (or department) under

4. Source stated that in addition to the pay, which was favorable according to Soviet standards, there was also the additional incentive of possibly being able to make a trip abroad as an interpreter. There was some conversation with the Source concerning payment of expenses while abroad and Source indicated that the amount paid depended upon the position but that actually the normal Soviet employee did not receive much money for additional expenses.

5. During this conversation, Source was asked whether Soviets were permitted to take any money abroad to spend. Source scolled at this question and then stated that his mother, when she traveled abroad, was only permitted to take the equivalent of about \$50 with her when she left the Soviet Union. was not aware that the mother of Source had ever been abroad, this particular matter was developed further.

6. Source stated that in 1956, after the death of his father, his mother accompanied Madame KOSYGINA on a trip to Western Europe and the Mediterranean. According to Source, this was a cruise type tour aboard the first "Russian cruise ship," Source was of the opinion that the name of the ship was the Pobeda and described it as a former German ship. On the trip, passengers stayed on board ship at night even while visiting ports with the exception that his mother did visit Paris where she remained over night. According to Source, the above ship stopped in Belgium and Holland and also several Mediterranean ports including Greece, Turkey and Italy.

7. No checks are considered necessary in regard to the above

In addition, there is a possibility that a check of certain foreign newspapers during the appropriate period of time might disclose a reference to the mother of Scurce as having accompanied Madame KOSYGINA on the above tour.




