1. Two recent FBI letterhead memoranda, Washington, D. C., dated 10 March 1969, captioned [redacted] Internal Security - R and New York, New York, dated 14 March 1969, captioned [redacted] have characterized Yuri NOSENKO as "a confidential source, a former Soviet intelligence officer." Also, a Los Angeles memorandum dated 12 February 1969, captioned [redacted] in connection with sourcing information from NOSENKO about [redacted] used the source description "a former Soviet intelligence officer, who has provided reliable information in the past."

2. In the past your Bureau and this Agency quite consistently have characterized NOSENKO as "a former Committee of State Security (KGB) officer whose bona fides has not been established," without noting as did your New York, New York office on 3 March 1969 in a memorandum captioned [redacted] that NOSENKO is a confidential source. 3. This agency continues to believe that any source description for NOSENKO should include the phrase "whose bona fides has not been established." It is proposed, therefore, that the following characterization of NOSENKO be used in all reporting and correspondence by both your Bureau and this Agency:

"A confidential source, a former Committee of State Security (KGB) officer whose bona fides has not been established but who has provided generally reliable information about KGB agents and personnel in the past ---."

1. Reference is made to your memorandum on Subject,
dated 30 October 1968.

2. We note with interest your statement that Subject
was assigned as [REDACTED] in New Delhi from
1960 to 1962. As you state, NOSENKO has reported that
Vyacheslav Vasilyevich BARSKIY, a case officer of the
KGB's Second Chief Directorate working against foreign
correspondents, was working against Subject in 1954-55
while Subject was assigned to Moscow. On a previous
occasion NOSENKO reported that BARSKIY had worked for
the former Fourteenth (counterintelligence) Department
of the First Chief Directorate from 1961 to 1963, when
he was assigned to a metallurgical plant in Bhilai, India.
We are, unfortunately, unable to confirm BARSKIY's assign-
ment to India.
