In response to questioning, informant said he has heard nothing in KGB Headquarters, Moscow, in the recent past concerning ANATOLI GOLITZYN or YURI NOSENKO, both of whom defected to American intelligence authorities within the past several years. Both had previously been affiliated with the KGB. ~~(X)~~(u)

In response to further questioning, informant said he considered both of these individuals to be "legitimate" defectors. He said that it is now known that before GOLITZYN defected he accumulated a great deal of information from KGB Headquarters, Moscow, for eventual passage to American intelligence authorities. ~~(X)~~(u)

Informant said KGB would certainly be interested in knowing the whereabouts of GOLITZYN and NOSENKO and observed that if the organization did know their locations he felt certain that some attempt would be made to "capture" them and return them to the Soviet Union where they would have to stand trial for their traitorous acts. ~~(X)~~(u)

Informant then stated that no one in KGB knew where these two defectors were now although it was presumed that they were residing in the U. S. probably under different names and in areas far removed from locations of Soviet establishments. Through further questioning on this point, the informant said that GOLITZYN or any other KGB defector would be a "fool" to live anywhere near a Soviet establishment for there was always the possibility that he might be recognized, which might set off a number of possible actions by KGB through its personnel in the U. S. ~~(X)~~(u)

In an ensuing discussion, informant said he thought there was no possibility at all of KGB, under its Disinformation Program of offering a "defector" to western intelligence authorities who was really a "plant" for KGB. Informant said this type of operation would be extremely difficult to operate and even more difficult to maintain. He said from the standpoint of KGB he did not consider it practical since there would be no advantage at all to KGB unless the "defector plant" was able to eventually obtain access to restricted and classified information. Informant said otherwise KGB would be handicapping itself since it would be necessary for the "plant" to keep furnishing information to western intelligence, all or most of which could quickly be "checked out" or verified for accuracy. Informant indicated that "disinformation" might be passed in a very limited segment in such a manner but said that as an overall program to be carried out by a "plant" it would be untenable. ~~(X)~~(u)

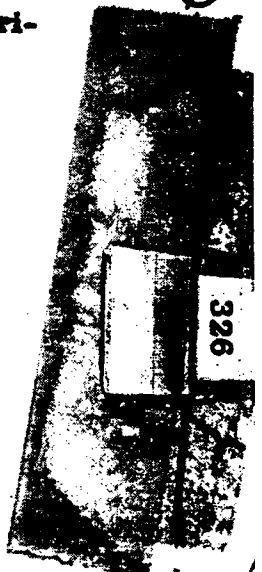

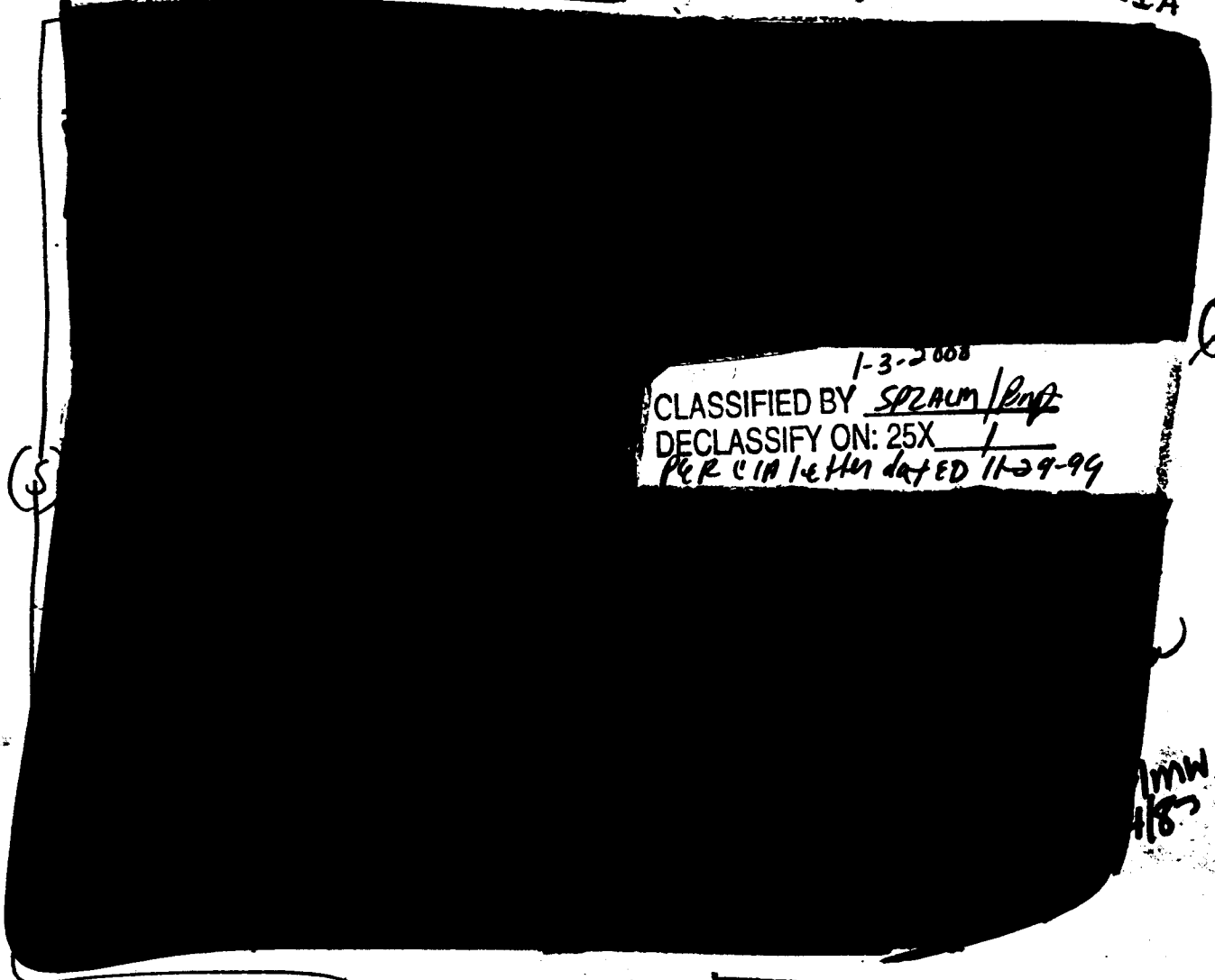
