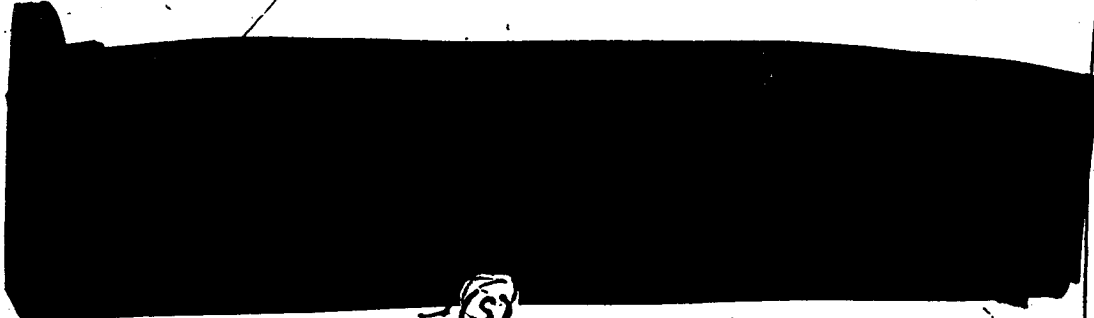

# Russian Police Grill ~~SECRET~~ Oakland YMCA Leader

John Thune, general executive of the Metropolitan YMCA of Alameda County, underwent two nights of interrogation by the Russian secret police during the Metropolitan Y's 11th International Adventure tour of Europe and the Soviet Union.

"It was like something out of a spy movie," Thune told The Tribune today in a telephone interview from Rome just after the group arrived there.

Thune was in Gurzuf, Russia, July 9, with his wife, Eleanor, and 22 Bay Area youths, including the Thunes' son, Brad Armstrong, 14. Thune said he heard a night-time knock on his door, and when he answered it he was surrounded by four plainclothes policemen and taken to an interrogation room. "They threatened to kill me or harm my group if I didn't cooperate," Thune said. "But I refused to sign anything."

After four hours of accusations, threats and questions about the FBI, the CIA and the U.S. military structure, Thune was warned not to mention the interrogation to anyone. He was then released.

The following day Thune and his group traveled about 500 miles to Kiev, where he was picked up again. His wife was held, too. They were questioned separately by interrogators who insisted the Thunes sign confessions written in Russian. Both refused. The group was allowed to leave Russia the following day, and Thune reported the incident to the U.S. consulate in Vienna, Austria.

This is his story, written July 17 in Vienna:

It was late in the evening. There was a sharp knock on the door. Before I could collect my thoughts the door opened and there I was, surrounded by four Soviet secret policemen!

This was my third visit to the Soviet Union with YMCA youths in the last 10 years. I had always worried that authorities might provoke an "incident." Now that moment had come -- I was face to

face with the dreaded Soviet secret police.

Our YMCA group of 22 young men and young women, plus my wife and me, had just completed two weeks in the U.S.S.R. We had visited Leningrad, Moscow and now we were terminating a week's stay in the Soviet youth camp Sputnik in Gurzuf on the shores of the Black Sea near Yalta.

In this camp there were

Czech, Polish, East German, Hungarian and Soviet youths. We were the only Americans in camp.

During this week we had participated in the Crimean Small Olympic Games. We placed second behind the U.S.S.R. in the team standings.

The Soviets had placed some pressure upon us to sign a resolution backed by all the other nations present that con-

demned the "imperialist American aggressors" for most of the wrongs in the world and that the teachings of Lenin are the only way for mankind. This resolution was to be a part of a large art festival to be held in the camp. I told them a resounding no and that this was an insult.

After two days of negotiations, a simple resolution was

adopted that eliminated the references to America and that Lenin was "the only way." We had some courageous help from the Czech and Hungarian leaders in drafting this amended document. The Soviet leaders in Camp Sputnik seemed to be perturbed over this U.S. "victory."

We were making friends among the young people in camp. This was giving me some anxiety for I felt the Soviet authorities might provoke an "incident."

On our last night in camp we were notified that we would be leaving the next day at 5 a.m. Instead of the scheduled 1 p.m. I became even more apprehensive.

That night, on July 9, there was the knock on my door. I

was surrounded by four secret policemen. More were outside the ground floor window and many more were in the hallway. I was declared an enemy of the Soviet state.

My bags were searched. They confiscated some American and English newspapers and magazine articles along with a YMCA information paper on the Soviet Union. None could be considered "anti-Soviet."

I was taken upstairs and interrogated by two secret police for most of the night. I was told that I was a very clever man and to "stop beating around the bush" and confess.

I (also) was told that I could be killed and that my young son, Brad, who was traveling with us, and members of the group could be harmed if I did not cooperate. The chief interrogator said to me, "You foolish Americans with all your freedom. In our state we will control our people and you too!"

I was told to leave the room and to return in a short time at 4:30 a.m. with all the literature our young people had brought with them from America -- without arousing suspicions. Also, at 4:30 a.m. I would be required to sign a "confession."

Returning at the designated time, I turned over a small

handful of booklets. The only thing that might have been considered anti-Soviet by stretching the imagination was a paperback copy of Levine's "Mainstreet U.S.S.R." We had been accused of distributing anti-Soviet literature. We had not.

A long document, typed and read to me in Russian, was placed before me for my signature. I refused. By the way, I do not understand Russian. They continued to "encourage" me. I resolutely refused. Then they said it would not be necessary for me to sign as they would sign their own names attesting to my "guilt."

Then I was informed that these conversations would continue upon my arrival in Kiev that night. I was again warned that I had better cooperate.

On the night of July 10 in Kiev my wife and I were about to retire when the telephone rang. We were informed that we would be picked up in a few minutes and taken to the Hotel Ukraina for questioning.

Arriving at the Hotel Ukraina my wife and I were taken to an upstairs room and seated at a table illuminated with a dim light hanging above. Here we were viciously interrogated by the same two men who had been the primary men talking to me in Gurnaf the night before. They again stated that I was a very clever man and they knew all about me. I tried to question them about my life. In return I was brusquely informed, "We are asking the questions."

My wife was ordered from the room for separate interrogation. There was obviously a microphone communications setup between the interrogation rooms and a central headquarters. Advice was coming almost continuously over a telephone from another source.

My wife was taken to another dimly lit room and severely questioned by two other men. A variety of persons would come in and out of the room.

The police wanted to know all about her activities in her program position at the International House at the University of California at Berkeley. What did she know about the

Soviet students? She was firmly urged to influence me to "confess."

After several hours of intense questioning we were released on the morning of July 11 without having signed anything. I never did understand the full particulars of the trumped up "confession."

It was interesting to note that at least one of our interrogators had been a "good friend" of our youth at Camp Sputnik on the Black Sea.

The only further incident was the intensive search of all my wife's possessions at the Kiev airport on July 12 prior to our departure to Vienna, Austria. They even searched the lining of her purse and probed her face creams.

Upon my arrival in Vienna I literally kissed the ground. Freedom is a priceless thing!

Now that our young people have been informed of this incident with the secret police, there seems to be a genuine appreciation of home. These youths have begun to realize that there is a great difference between the friendly Soviet man on the street who is seeking a better life and the leaders of the Soviet state with their repressive policies.

The Soviet Bear is on the move in the Middle East, the presence on the shores of the Black Sea, their launching point, may have heightened their surveillance of us.
