He always went out of his way to help the lonely ones, showed them the sights, even took them to restaurants where they invariably met Russians who seemed not at all afraid to talk freely with Westerners.

"Older embassy hands were skeptical about Sig, knowing that he was probably a Soviet spy. After all, local help in Moscow must be nired from U.P.D.K., the government personnel agency for foreign employers. But if the embassy fired Sig, they reasoned, he would probably only be replaced by another spy who might be a bounder to boot. In any case, the younger Britons, who invited him to their parties and went to his, felt certain that he hated the Russians. 'You see', explained Sig, 'I'm a Pole.' He made a determined pass at every new English girl he met--and at the boys as well. When they resisted, he explained mournfully that life in Moscow was hard on a passionate Pole.'

"Unusual Happening's. Alas, poor Sigi 1956, with no advance warning, the British fired him. Not without cause. Sig's saga finally came to light last week in a remarkably bland report by the judicial tribunal that has spent three months investigating the latest British spy scandal: the stange case of William John Vassall, a homosexual Admiralty clerk who had been assigned to the Moscow embassy for two years, and had been spying for the Russians for seven.
