KGB round up 19 Ukrainians

Moscow, January 19

Nineteen people are now known to have been arrested in a KGB security police round-up in the Ukraine last week of those suspected of nationalist or anti-Soviet activities, usually reliable sources said here today.

They said there had been 12 arrests in the republic's capital of Kiev and a further seven in the West Ukrainian city of Lvov, a centre of strong Ukrainian nationalist feeling. Those held by the KGB included the author Yevgen Sverstyuk, the sources said.

The wave of arrests follows several articles in the official press condemning what the authorities see as "nationalist survivals" in the Ukraine. Meanwhile, the Belgian Embassy here said it has received confirmation that a Belgian tourist, M Yaroslav Dobosh, had been arrested in the Ukraine for "subversive anti-Soviet activity." — Reuter,

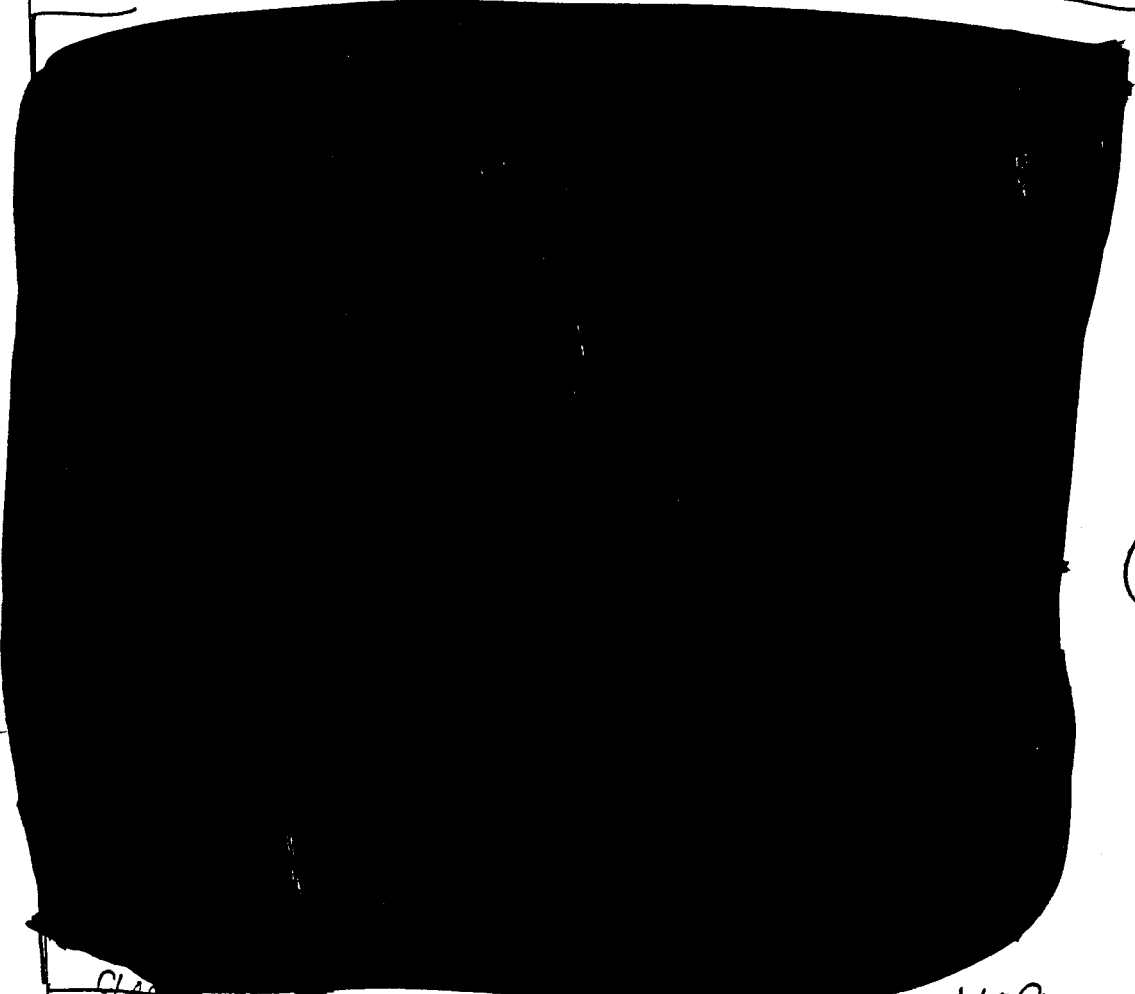

WFO has also asked if we could determine from [REDACTED] if the KGB Residencies maintain photographs of individuals and as to current instructions in the event a defector is spotted by a Soviet. These are legitimate questions and [REDACTED] should be able to shed some light on them. The other questions suggested by WFO concern the "recall telegram" which was reportedly sent to Nosenko just prior to his defection. There are conflicting stories concerning this telegram.
