If not, is source aware of any conferences at KGB Residencies shortly after NOSENKO's defection became known which discussed NOSENKO's defection? If so, did the conference indicate specifically that a "recall telegram" was sent, or was this implied? Is it possible that instead of a "recall telegram," KGB urgent communications were sent to KGB Residencies discussing the defection and these telegrams were alluded to in conferences at KGB Residencies? If not, is it possible, as suggested in the enclosure, that references to a "recall telegram" was merely personal speculation based on press stories of the defection?

In the event is able to furnish positive, pertinent information, WFO will await Bureau instructions concerning the preparation of a LHM; however, the information in the enclosure should not be disseminated outside the FBI.



WFO has also asked if we could determine from if the KGB Residencies maintain photographs of individuals and as to current instructions in the event a defector is spotted by a Soviet. These are legitimate questions and should be able to shed some light on them. The other questions suggested by WFO concern the "recall telegram" which was reportedly sent to Nosenko just prior to his defection. There are conflicting stories concerning this telegram. Furnished information which had come to his attention in 1964 concerning this telegram and it would certainly not appear that he would be able to enlarge upon this information at this time.
