





INFORMATIVE NOTE

Nosenko, Soviet KGB Officer who defected.

A serious question was raised after his defection concerning his bona fides by CIA and in particular by James Angeleton, CIA official who retired in December, 1974.

After a complete reexamination of the information furnished by Nosenko, CIA concluded that he was a bona fide defector.

During the investigation of the iOswald case, Nosenko was interviewed on 3/3/64, and stated at the time Oswald arrived in Russia, he (Nosenko) was Deputy Chief of the KGB section investigating tourists. He stated that Oswald during his stay in Russia was not recruited by the KGB.

Attached airtel reported that Angeleton has advised a CIA official he feels compelled to raise the question of Nosenko's bona fides with the U.S. Senate, presumably the SSC. This will, of course, cast doubt on the statement by Nosenko that Oswald was not recruited by the KGB and add further ammunition to those individuals who have been attacking the investigation conducted by the Warren

McCone during a May, 1975 CBS news interview that the bona fides of source has been established. Speculation within the Office of Security, CIA was that the former high-ranking American intelligence official might be JAMES ANGLETON, and the second former official might be one of the two subordinates of ANGELETON who went on forced retirement with him recently. 
