SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD, aka.

AT NEW ORLEANS, LA.

A source advised SA PECK on 12/11/63 that on same date source happened to be in the office of the Assistant District Attorneys, Orleans Parish, La., [REDACTED] Assistant District Attorney for Orleans Parish, BERNARD FOTO, and overheard him state before approximately five or six other persons in this office that approximately August or September, 1963, LEE HARVEY OSWALD was in the District Attorneys' Office for Orleans Parish, La., contacting EDWARD GILLAN, Assistant District Attorney, Juvenile Court Office, regarding "bringing something into the country." Source stated that source did not understand what FOTO meant by this remark but added that since he commented as set out above, within the hearing of numerous persons, possibly his words had some basis in fact. (b)(7)(D)

Source stated source could furnish no additional information relative to this matter.

[On the evening of 1/23/67 at approximate 8:21 o'clock] [REDACTED] contacted me by phone at my home and advised as follows:

[REDACTED] related that shortly before his call his wife had received a call from an unknown man who told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was no good, that he was working with the District Attorney's office, (City of N.O.) in the latter's investigation relative to the murder of President Kennedy, and the Oswald matter, and that if he didn't stop bothering the "opposition" he could be killed.]

(b)(2)(c)(b)(7)(D)

[REDACTED] related that he had called the police and they were at his home at the time he was making the call to my house. [REDACTED] was informed that he had called the proper authorities, the NOPD and that there was no Federal jurisdiction based on his statement of the facts. He related that he had been under that impression, but wanted to make certain. He was reminded that if he felt there was any need for protection of him or his wife that the FBI does not afford physical protection adding that this was the responsibility of the local law enforcement agency involved. He acknowledged that he was aware of that fact.
