[REDACTED] appeared at the New Orleans Office on December 17, 1963 and advised that she had spoken to Captain NEVILLE LEVY of the Equitable Equipment Company, where she is employed and mentioned that she had been interviewed by the FBI and she stated that Mr. LEVY was "extremely short" with her and stated that he told her that he did not appreciate his employees associating his company with the assassination of President KENNEDY. [REDACTED] was concerned that possibly the FBI had told Captain LEVY that she was involved or interviewed by the FBI and further she was concerned whether people would think that she had reported Mrs. MARTIN to the FBI.

[REDACTED] was advised that the files of the FBI are confidential and that any information she furnished to the FBI would be maintained in confidence. b7D

I inquired of him as to what he wanted photographs for and he stated Life Magazine was preparing a photographic study of the life of OSWALD and they were looking for photographs of his attendance at school, birthday parties, or anywhere else in order to complete this photographic study.

I informed him of the confidential nature of the records of the FBI and inquired as to whether or not he had checked with the local newspaper morgues or local TV stations; he stated he had not but intended to do so.

Deputy LEONARD SPEARS, East Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office, Baton Rouge, La. advised on Dec. 23, 1963, upon viewing photos maintained in 89-69-1A73 that the person that he saw on television shortly after the assassination of the President was not in these photographs or that he could not identify this person in any of these photographs. He stated that the person he saw on the television film had a large nose and that Charles Hall Steele, Jr. in the photos resembled this person. He stated that he could not say if this was the person he saw on television but did not think that it was. He stated that he saw McCurley when he was arrested and thought this person he saw on television was McCurley although he could not think of his name at the time he saw the program.

copy of photos maintained by Sheriff's Office was conducted by SA

Rosemary Boudreaux, 218 Magnolia St., Gonzales, La., advised on 12/24/63, that she works the 3 PM to 11 PM shift at the Baton Rouge General Hospital and that she rides the Continental Bus from Gonzales to Baton Rouge each day. She stated that she can not recall any particular day as to any one being on the bus. She ~~stated~~ stated that she gets on the bus and sits in a front seat and then departs the bus in front of the hospital before it gets to the bus station. She stated that she does not see any of the people in the back of the bus and does not pay any attention to any of the passengers. She stated that she does not recall having ever seen Oswald or anyone resembling him to her knowledge.
