At 10:18 a.m., 3/12/64, [redacted] talked to SAC JIM COLE at San Antonio in regard to the lead set out in Legat airtel to the Bureau dated 2/27/64 which deals with locating and interviewing HOMER VAUHAN.

I advised SAC COLE that New Orleans had previously made inquiries at Ferriday, Louisiana in effort to identify and locate VAUHAN without success and no one in the area could recall any resident or former resident by the aforementioned name. I also advised COLE that in connection with other tourist permits for persons going to Mexico, New Orleans had determined that when such permits are issued by Mexican Consulate in New Orleans the Consulate requires that an application form be filled out which gives considerably more information that was set out in the Legat's airtel or in a prior message along the same lines which was received from San Antonio by San Antonio airtel 12/3/63.

SAC COLE stated he would check to determine if an application form was submitted in the issuance of HOMER VAUHAN's travel permit and send a teletype to New Orleans setting forth the results of this check on 3/12/64.

Re Memo ASAC Sylvester, 3/13/64 and entitled: "Jack L. Ruby; Lee Harvey Oswald (Deceased) - Victim. Cr."

In response to referenced memo I contacted the Dallas Office ^{3/13/64} by phone but was unable to speak to ASAC Kyle Clark. I furnished the following material to Clerk Dave Lofland of Dallas who relayed same to ASAC CLARK;

I advised LOFLAND that ~~that~~ I did not receive any original item from anyone at the Dallas PD as best I can recall, except that material that was received from the Dallas PD in bulk and inventoried at the Dallas Office on or about 11/26 or 27/63. This was done in the presence of Captain English of the Dallas PD and his property man whose name I cannot now recall. I advised LOFLAND that unless someone had removed the letter from PAVEL GOLOVACHEN from the material obtained by the Dallas PD from Oswald's and Paine's residence prior to the time the material was turned over by Dallas P.D. in inventoried form on 11/26 or 27/63, that that same letter should have been among the material in the inventory. I advised LOFLAND that I recall that Detective Dhority of the Dallas PD gave me a photostat or photographic copy of a letter or letters which I placed in a L-4 envelope for the Oswald file at Dallas.

I also mentioned that there was a secret service agent at the PD going thru Oswald's material on or about 11/24/63 whose name was Steuart (ph)

LOFLAND relayed this information to ASAC CLARK who indicated the above answer covered the information he needed to know about.

At 4:40 p.m., ASAC KYLE CLARK, Dallas, telephonically advised they are looking for the original of a letter dated 9/30/63 from PAVEL GOLOVACHEV to LEE HARVEY OSWALD in the states, written from Minsk, Russia. He stated the Commission, the FBI in Washington, and Secret Service in Washington, and the FBI in Dallas all have machine copies of this letter, the original of which was picked up by the Dallas PD in the search of the PAINE residence or the OSWALD room on 11/22/63 because it has the initials "RSS, 11/22/63" which are the initials of R. S. STOVALL of the Dallas PD.

In connection with this, Dallas has three 1-A exhibit envelopes in the file showing there were machine copies received by SA WARREN C. deBRUEYS from Sgt. DHORITY at the PD on 11/24/63, which was the date OSWALD was killed, and there was a lot of confusion. Dallas stated deBRUEYS may remember going to the PD on 11/24/63 and getting the three machine copies, or maybe that he was given the three letters and made the copies himself.

ASAC CLARK advised the above letter is the one they are looking for, and the other two are from ERIC TITOVETS from Minsk. He stated on 2/4/64, Captain FRITZ at the PD turned up the originals of the two letters from TITOVETS and Dallas sent them to the Bureau. Dallas PD cannot locate the original of the third letter.
