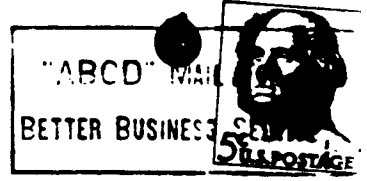

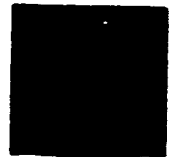

I am writing to You as a person vitally interested in the preservation of historical data pertaining to the United States.

It has come to my attention that the accused assassin of our late President Kennedy, Lee Harvey Oswald, worked for Your company in part of May and June of 1963. I hope that it is not too late for me to hope that Your company may still have, in its personnel records, application for employment, or otherwise, some fragment, signed or unsigned, in the handwriting of Oswald.

I would very much appreciate having anything at all of this nature, which You might have retained. And while my financial resources are not great, if You would wish some remuneration for such an item, please advise the worth You would place upon it, and I would attempt, within reason, to oblige. I hope that, in the interests of history, You will do what You can to locate some bit of Oswald's handwriting.

ReButels to New Orleans 7/17/64, one sent at 12:21 p.m. and the other at 7:27 p.m.

On the morning of 7/21/64, WESLEY JAMES LIEBELER, staff member of the President's Commission, called in person at the New Orleans Office. He consulted with SAs RICHARD E. LOGAN, STEPHEN M. CALLENDER and WARREN C. deBRUEYS. He was furnished results of information contained in report of SA deBRUEYS dated 7/17/64 at New Orleans and entitled "CHANGED, OREST PENA, aka, IS - CUBA".

Mr. LIEBELER also displayed a photograph of OSWALD and a group of other people in front of the Trade Mart reflecting OSWALD distributing handbills. He was still anxious to know whether or not one of the persons in the photograph attired with white shirt and who appeared to be passing out handbills, had been identified. SA CALLENDER advised Mr. LIEBELER that this party had not been identified and outlined the investigation that had been conducted in an effort to so identify him.

Mr. LIEBELER said that he would be taking depositions from OREST PENA, RUPERTO PENA and EVARISTO RODRIGUEZ this morning. He was advised SA LOGAN would be present at his interviews of RODRIGUEZ and RUPERTO PENA in the event he needed SA LOGAN's services as an interpreter.
