At 12:06 p.m., 11/21/64, an individual who identified himself as GARY HYMEL called the New Orleans Office and talked to ASAC SYLVESTER.

HYMEL stated he was calling to get the name of the Agent who observed OSWALD and who was subsequently called to Springfield, Ill. after which he resigned.

ASAC SYLVESTER advised HYMEL he had no comment to make.

At 12:22 p.m., 11/21/64, Supervisor DON HENNING in Mr. deLOACH's Office, was advised that above inquiry had been received and the response to same. HENNING was also informed that inquiry of BILL MANNING of the States Item determined that HYMEL, who is a States-Item employee and also a special correspondent for Time Magazine, was getting together some information for Time Magazine for some type of article the above magazine plans to write in connection with Mr. HOOVER's comments made during the week of 11/16/64.

Secret Service Expansion

Announcement of the impending addition of 75 persons to its personnel within the next few months as part of a Secret Service program developed since the Kennedy assassination which will, among other things, mean a total personnel addition of about 200. Elaborate cross-filing of "suspects" through business-machine devices is an immediate objective.

The types of suspects in regard to presidential security are being enlarged in number, while attempts to resolve workable criteria for this purpose have involved wide consultations.

Since the Secret Service claimed that Lee Harvey Oswald would have been in its files in a top position had it known everything about him that other agencies did, it is evident that the "Oswald classification" alone will take in quite a number of individuals who have given or may give no known indication of violent tendency other than wife-beating, drunkenness or getting into a political street fight.

Marina Oswald, the only person other than her husband who knew he had attempted previously an assassination, kept silent until it was too late.

The Warren Report, on this subject, insisted it was attempting no "counsel of perfection" in regard to assessing the "assassin" potential of various types of individual; was not relying on hindsight. In agreeing in effect, however, that Oswald should have been under surveillance not only as a national, but as a presidential security risk, it came pretty close nevertheless to such counsel. High court decisions, in a number of instances, have leaned to the protection of individuals, in the field of national security, against "imagination," or too much of it; have leaned to the narrow, rather than broad, restriction on society and its agents in this field; have paid heed to the overt, as against the possible or even probable, indication of danger.

That the subject of presidential security is of very high importance, if not the highest, cannot be gainsaid. But it remains as before one of the most difficult of all tasks, even to insure a material degree of improved protection, as against "guarantee," without instituting evaluations and measures that will produce effects ranging from ludicrous to painful. We doubt anyone has the answer.

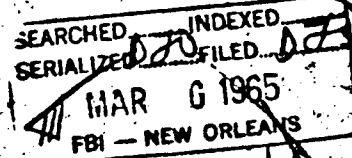
