You don't know how much I appreciate the bookmarker. Books have played a very important part in my life and, actually, I would be lost if they took them out of my world. To me it is something special and I hope I live to a ripe old age and I will get many a thought in the years to come as I read and see your name there.

You will note that I am enclosing a letter to Mrs. Lee Oswald but I thought you, better than anyone, would understand my motive and enclosure and at the same time, should something of an embarrassing nature come up in the future, it would be apparent to all concerned that my motive was right and that I used that I consider to be unquestioned channels.

Lee, we sent some money down for Patrolman Trippett but some- way when I read this morning that fund had reached \$312,000 plus I got to thinking of Mrs. Oswald with her two children, an alien woman in a strange land, and she, in turn, has to raise those children and I believe that she was caught up in circumstances which were not of her making.

I am sure the FBI in Ft. Worth knows of her whereabouts and could I indulge on your generosity to deliver this check and I am enclosing a copy of my letter should you desire to use it as a transmittal letter.

We will be looking forward to seeing you and Jean Saturday night and would you give my best Christmas greetings to your staff, and always the best wishes to you and yours.

I have an SAC contact here who is a millionaire several times over, and I believe a copy of his letter to me is self-explanatory. [redacted] is probably one of the most cooperative contacts you could have. He would work for nothing for the Bureau. He has been [redacted] in Texas, grew up in this section and there is no "ism" to his thinking or any of his family. He is simply a person who has plenty of money and desires to do something worthwhile. He has told me how badly he felt about the President's death. I know he feels, as all of us do, that it was a terrible tragedy, but in his letter you will note he says he feels that Mrs. Oswald is a victim of circumstances. I understand some of the Agents are talking to her, and that she has been most cooperative. You will know her address, and all you need to do is to put the check in an envelope and send it to her. I know the motives of the donor - strictly humanitarian.

He did not enclose a letter to Mrs. Oswald, but added a note on the top of his letter to me that he just decided to put "Children's Christmas" on the check.
