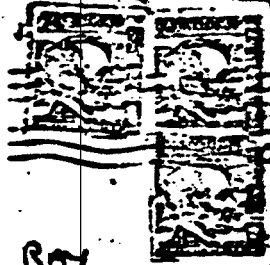

Memphis has transmitted to us copies of two separate letters addressed to James Earl Ray as made available by [REDACTED] of the Memphis, Tennessee, Police Department who is in charge of the security of James Earl Ray at the Shelby County Jail, Memphis, Tennessee. Letter number one is postmarked 8-22-68 at Goleta, California, from [REDACTED] and letter number two is postmarked 9-5-68 at [REDACTED] California, from [REDACTED] Clements, California. These letters in general offer assistance to subject Ray in the form of financial help and generally are sympathetic towards Ray.

Memphis has instructed Los Angeles and Sacramento to identify the [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and instructions are being given by this teletype to restrict identification through check of office indices, police department and credit Bureau records and not to interview. Short. The handwriting in these letters will be examined by our laboratory. Bureau indices negative re [REDACTED] Identification record of one [REDACTED] being forwarded to Los Angeles and Sacramento under separate cover, which list numerous arrests from 2-3-68 to 9-29-68.
