Results of examination:

The lead cores of the bullets in the five cartridges, Q4 through Q3, were found to vary in composition even though they were all from the same manufacturor.

The core portion of the Q64 bullet fragment from the victim's body is cimilar in composition to the lead core of the bullot in the cartridge designated Q4 and could have come from a source such as represented by the lead core of the bullet in Q4.

The bullet jacket portion of specimen Q64 is similar in composition to the motal of the jackets of the bullets in the Q4 through Q8 cartridges and could have come from the source represented by these bullets.
