IMPERSONATION

A copy of this memorandum is being furnished to
IRS, San Francisco.

On June 10, 1971, [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] San Francisco, California, appeared at the
San Francisco Office of the FBI and alleged that an individual
named [REDACTED] had been representing himself to her and
her roommate, [REDACTED], as a "secret government agent,"
working for the FBI and other agencies. [REDACTED] further alleged
that [REDACTED] had obtained money from [REDACTED] on the basis of
this representation and that [REDACTED] plans to marry [REDACTED]

On June 10, 1971, [REDACTED] was inter-
viewed by Bureau agents at the above address. [REDACTED] stated
that [REDACTED] had indicated to her that he was affiliated with
the Justice Department and Treasury Department as a federal
law enforcement agent. She admitted she had given him money,
but it was given to him because he told her his funds were
presently "frozen" due to legal problems rather than because
of any alleged impersonation. She said that she had recently
accompanied [REDACTED] to the offices of Internal Revenue Service,
450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, and waited in the lobby,
while he allegedly transacted business there with his associates.

On June 10, 1971, Special Agent [REDACTED] Internal
Revenue Service, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, identified
[REDACTED] as an individual who had contacted his office several
weeks before, using the name [REDACTED] and attempting to
impart what he thought to be useful information. Special
Agent [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] information on this occasion
was judged to be fictitious and worthless, as was the case
with information obtained from [REDACTED] on previous occasions
by Internal Revenue Service in San Francisco, Sacramento,
and several Eastern offices.

On June 11, 1971, [REDACTED] was interviewed by FBI
agents at San Francisco. During this interview, [REDACTED] denied

having ever represented himself to anyone at any time as a federal law enforcement agent. He stated he merely "helps" the federal government from time to time. Names and addresses in his possession at time of interview included the following:

The facts of this matter were discussed with Assistant United States Attorney JAMES L. HAZARD, San Francisco on July 12, 1971. Mr. HAZARD stated that he would decline prosecution in this matter inasmuch as there is insufficient evidence that [REDACTED] actually represented himself to be a federal agent or that anything of value was obtained through such alleged representation.

Sunnyside, Long Island, New York, entered the office of the FBI, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, at the request of SA [redacted]. [redacted] was promptly advised of the identities of SA [redacted] and SA [redacted] and of his rights, as shown on the executed Advice of Rights form.

[redacted] provided the following information to SAs [redacted] and [redacted].

All his identification papers are in New York. He is not now, or ever has been, any type of federal agent. He stated he merely told [redacted] and [redacted] of [redacted] that he "helps" the government from time to time. He was employed by [redacted], Sunnyside, Long Island, New York, as a cook until about a year ago.
