LATENT PRINT EXAMINATION

Two latent palm prints and one latent impression, which is either a fingerprint or partial palm print, of value were found on three of the lifts from the 1966 white Mustang recovered in Atlanta. No latent prints were found or developed on any of the other items submitted for latent print examination from this car.

The two latent palm prints and the latent impression are not identical with the other latent impressions remaining unidentified in this case.
