This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) through a review of 270,000 passports issued by Canadian officials identified a passport issued for the subject under name of Ramon George Sneyd.

The attached teletype recommends letter of appreciation from the Director to the Commissioner of the RCMP for the valuable assistance rendered by individuals who worked on the project and appreciation for assistance of the passport section. It is recommended that an individual letter be addressed to Constable J. R. Murray who originally made the identification in the case. The General Investigative Division concurs that the letters should not contain any reference either to the Martin Luther King assassination or the identity of James Earl
