When I one I'll be giving you memos on individual records when there seems to be a point in doing so. In this I'll be addressing the FBI's techniq was of defauntion, non-compliances (which makes me think we should ask for affidavits of compliance) and some of the specifies of the records.

This copy of 62-106060-6595 is the file copy of the Domestic Intelligence Pivision. Sallivan's is the only name marked in the stamp for routing and the rubber stamp visible in reverse at the bottom is of that Division.

there is a notation only partly comprehensible at the lower left-hand corner of the first page. It appears to say Retained in St.S. the second 8 unclear and possibly not an S. It everlaps with a rubber stamp that in reverse reads "negative." I'm not certain this is the entire rubber stamp.

To the left of this is another stamped on form. I believe that in the part not eliminated the initials that remain are of Raymond E. Long. if I recall that name correctly.

Above these notations is the routing of copies by the N.O. fielf office. With the three copies sent to the Bureau there are 9 enclosures, none of which I new when I went over this covering Airtel and the meet of the volume. If they are mentioned in the LHM, which also has an "enclosure" stemp, I'll go into that as I read the LHM. I've skinsed only part of the first page to now.

I'd have assumed a copy to Ballas but not to "ousten. This is absolute proof that a denial of any records by the "ousten F.O. is knowingly false.

One enclosure to it and to Dallas. Histauped 9 enclosures also.

HQ also noted what appears to be "SNIP 6592. Whatever this means, there is no 6952 in this Section. At the same point there is another file designation, 44 1-4-3. With 44 indicating "Civil Rights," I wonder is this is a sub of a King file.

The names and initials added are Sullivans, WCS for William C. Sublivan, Demaigan, what can be Raupach (there is such a name) and Goble. I take it Theodore M. Goble, who with Raupach figures in the records on se and I think other critics.

The underscorings are indicative of indexing indications. I do not recall having seem the wavy line below the names like below those of Dringuier and Turner in records I have gone over in the past. Perhps it san be their way of noting informers to the file clerks.

Naybe the 9 enclosures are those copies of the LMM and the 3 at the bottom refers to the Airtel copies.

While it is customery to say that Bufiles centain no Marrogatory information" on people, as here on Turner, they do not say no information at all. She was, if not their informant or source, without question a narcotice informant, at least for the N.O.P.D., Giarruso and Sgt. Spake. I checked this out. In fact, traced here there once to be sure. She may or may not have been a narcfink but she was well known to the two agents to whom I spoke and to whom I'd heard her speak by phone. Here I mean federal agents, federal fink.

Diome is not a common name and Bringuier fractures English badly. That he has the name right means to me that she did not lie to me about here earlier knowledge of and meetings with "ringuier, an some occasions with the Philip Geraci who is mentioned. On one of those pocasions, when he had run away and had returned to N.O., she met him and drove him to Bringuier's. Here I do not depend on her word. I have the juvenile report referred to quite incompletely. Geraci understated some of it. Instead of phoning his parents or the police Bringuier arranged to put him up at the Silver Pollar, where the boy was gang-banged.

Diene may have received the letter from Geraci she as said to have said she received but it could not possibly have said what is attributed to it.

Because I intend some carbons for other uses and filings here I ask that what I say about those who then were young people be kept confidential.

Diene, Philip and one Raul Navas were what for them would pass as friends, Raul was not much of a person from my experience with him. I believe Philip was honest with me and would have been more honest if it had not been for his mother. I believe that she forced him to break off with me.

This whole business marks one of the unethical practises of the Carrison office. I'm sure at in's direction. They brake their word to st ay out of this when I told them about it. As usual they were uttarly incompetent when they tried to steal what I was doing and would have given to them. I become quite marky on a couple of occasions and them addressed in and Moo Sciendra as I'm certain they had not been addressed.

One aspect was calling Raul in for an interview. As used it for a credited character assessination of "ione, whose character made that easy. But the stupidities of the Carrison office were not aware that she was also an excellent source, in some areas for and away my bost, even though she is the most natural and persuasive and accomplished liar I ever know well. Pantastic liar: I was lucky in deciding what to check out. All paid off.

So I got Iven to call Raul in for an interview by me. Raul agreed. Iven left us alone and I broke Raul down. It was easy with the guidance I obtained from liene, who was, naturally a ough, put out ever what he had done to her. I don't recall if Iven kept the tape to which had agreed. If I have it I don't recall where it is.

She know and had gone out with Layton "artens and Porry Russo. They both confirmed her stories to se. By the most remarkable of coincidences the night I possuaded her to trust me, at Burbara Reid's spartment, who turns up in the wee hours by artens, wanting to know abat is going on.

However, nome of this part of the A LIM is true. As of that time I'd never spoken or written to hilip. About April of that year I in did interview hilip's father and nother, on tape, played back to them. I obtained proof of Pringuier's false swearing to the Warren Commission - about Comald and about when he met Comald. I interviewed Philip in the hame of his lawyer, by pre-arrangement, and that it be in the lawyer's presence being my idea, that December.

In between the father, as electrician, died as the result of an electric shock.

Piene had told me that Philip and "and were homosexual. Garrison had a hangup on homosexuals over Shaw. She also told me that Shaw's pal ario Bernudez had seduced Philip neing a fancy our as buit and even telling me where the first encounter took place. I received partial confirmation from the parents, to whom I did not identify Philip with the use of that particular place popular enough high school hids by wealthy New Orleans homosexuals. They are among those who made representations to the Metairie school authorities.

One of my purposes was to protect bilip. Another was to learn what I could from him. With the first, which is entirely opposite what this LHM says, I was completely successful. With the second very successful. Bad I been able to spend more time in N.O. or to look him up later it could have led to much more good information.

If you want I'll tell you about the "hilip-Ferrie connection. 't is not relevant here. and of what happened to Philip within 24 hours of Ferrie's death, confirmed by the mother. I have these tapes.

Philip was in Viet Sam. Garrison had no plans for subposencing him from there. It is when Philip was retarned after his father's death that Carrison wanted to talk to him. The kid was so scared he can the risk of ignoring three subposences. I found out not from Garrison but from Dione.

With this record Carrison was quite willing to make a deal with me. I made it through alcock and arranged for the lawyer's husband, a judge, to confirm the deal so she'd know that on my own I'd arranged to shelter her client. They both, as a matter of fact, told me how unusual they found this and how much they appreciated it.

I helped her when the cop turned hipple was framed with a phoney plot to kill Nixon when himm needed a sympathetic press. This was when he addressed the VFV in N.O. The story then out out was so direct a steal from a N.O. Oswald story that appears never to have reached the Commission I was able to tell ohn South of the Enquirer what drug store it was supposed to have been overheard in - and I was right. Poor hipple Gaudet might have been killed for no reason except Nixon(s need for sympathy. Milliam when was his lawyer.

This bears all the earmarks of one of Dione's games because of the relationship each of these falsehood bears to what I can trace to her. Not that Bringuier had hired Geraci. He talked the kid into selling phoney Cuben bonds, without being hired. Not that bringuier and others had gone to a Cuben camp near New Orleans but that she and the two boys had and had seen Swald there. These are her stories to se. I don't knew if they are true or not. I'm inclined to doubt it save for two reasons; she knew the location of the camps and gave se an accurate description of one of which I was able to obtain pictures during 7/68.

So all of this as it relates to me is false. Note here that the LHM does not include such qualifiers as Bringueir said or it is alleged. They present it all as established fact. I present this is because the NO FO knew amough about se.

The first sentence of the third graf is another typical lie. The mother had not been approached by arrison. It is I to whom she and the father spoke, feely and openly at their home, without the taping in the open and as the tapes show, played back so they could be certain than in anxiety that had not misspoken themselves. (Now how many are this conceined when delicate family questions are involved and with "arrison's by then well-known proclivities? But I also had not make a deal for the mother. [ater I did.)

The next sentence is also presented as unquestioned truth. In fact it is fabrication. Attention is drawn to it by the note on the first page "See end p. 1) The words are:

Turner consented that an agency which she did not identify was building a case against Weisberg because he was spreading KGB propaganda in the United States. Pakrication unless she knew what she did not tell me.

The sentence at the top of the Till page is based on something real but is false. hillip was being returned over his father's death, if by October his father had died.

The story of the "ringuler-Geraci relationship is at best incomplete. It is in this run area that Bringuler swore falsely to establish an alibi for himself.

The parents made philip step selling the bonds. I have the receipts he got from Fringuier. It is almost certain that Oswald filed the complaint against Fringuier's unlicensed sale of bonds. And that he told Fringuier about it at the court hearing after the 8/63 fraces.

The date 8/5/63 is one of the two different false dates Bringuler gave for the Osmald section.

Notice, however, that the N.O.F.O. did have a file on Geraci. May? I can think only of his connection with the case, with me or both. It was not long after my joint interview with both the mother and indip that - got reports of FBI agents going around behind me and defaming me to those I'd spoken to. Notice the date, 5/5/68 for a minor juvenile offense of more than three years earlier.

Cludes Turner at several points and in some detail. (I have it.)

This tailored version seems designed to make it easy to destroy hilip's credibility. And to support Bringuler's false testimeny. Actually Philip hated his parents, and not without case. He was institutionalized over his compaign to get even with them, especially the father.
