PURPOSE:

The purpose of this memorandum is to consummate a request of Division 4 set forth in the referenced memorandum.

DETAILS:

A request was received in the FOIA PA section of Division 4 for color negatives of each of the three views of the death bullet in the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr. It was requested that each of the copy negatives be a slight enlargement of each of the original negatives. For purposes of cost computation, it took approximately three hours to produce the three negatives.
