If this pertains to the JAK/Criminal Division records, as it may not, may I please remind you that on a number of occasions I have asked you to let me know what there has been so accommissed extraordinarily long a time since triminal has provided any records and why some are neither provided nor accounted for, are unexplainedly missing from those that have been provided?

I have received nothing since before I appealed for the records of the special task force is support of the conclusions of the Warren Commission. I cannot avoid wondering if there is any connection between the delay and my noting this previously by unknown fact, of the existence and function of that task force.
