On August 9, 1963, LEE HARVEY OSWALD was arrested by the New Orleans Police Department, along with three other persons, on a charge of "Disturbing the Peace." It was determined subsequent to OSWALD's arrest, that he had been distributing pamphlets containing the writing "HANDS OFF CUBA Join the Fair Play for Cuba Committee, NEW ORLEANS CHARTER MEMBER BRANCH, Free Literature, Lectures, LOCATION: L. H. OSWALD, 4907 Magazine, New Orleans, La, EVERYONE WELCOMET

On August 16, 1963, two persons, one of which is believed identical with OSWALD, who identified themselves as being connected with the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC), distributed pamphlets in front of the International Trade Mart in New Orleans. They remained in that location for only a few moments and departed. This latter information was furnished on August 16, 1963, by who has a contractual relationship with the International Trade Mart and is a source of information relative to Latin American matters of the New Orleans Office. 4
