

To Quin Shea from Harold Weisberg JFK Assassination records 3/25/79

Appeal from referrals as a means of non-compliance

The unidentified subject of this Brennan to Sullivan memo from FBIHQ 105-82555 is one Gilberto Alvarado Ugarte.

The FBI makes three "charges" against the Director, Central Intelligence.

The third would seem to eliminate any need for there to have been any referral regarding Alvarado to the CIA.

As you are aware, since July 1977 the CIA has not acted on this and countless other referrals. During that time and for a longer time it has not complied with my and other requests for this information.

Without doubt the FBI also is aware.

It therefore seems, as the long record persuades, that despite this Brennan to Sullivan <sup>complaint</sup> about the "vicious and underhanded manner" of the CIA, the two agencies have re-established relations and have a mutual non-compliance pact centering on referrals on which neither ever gets around to acting.

If it has not come to your attention Mr. Ford was DeLoach's informant inside the Commission in a cozy deal in which their interests combined in opposition to the chairman of the Commission.
