In view of the fact that LEE HARVY OSWALD previously advised he had spoken to A.J. HIDEELL on the telephone between June 6 and August 10, 1963 at New Orleans, and also stated that he did not recall the phone number but it was disconnected by August 10, contact was made this date, at 11:15am, with [redacted] Southern Bell Telephone Co., New Orleans.

[redacted] was requested to arrange for an immediate check of all records at all Central Offices in this area, as well as the Accounting Records, in an attempt to determine if there is or ever has been a listing for A.J. HIDEELL, ALEX HIDEELL, ANA HIDEELL, or any HIDEELL. It was also requested that checks be made on variations of this name, such as HIDEELL, etc.

[redacted] stated that in view of the nature of this matter, full cooperation of the Phone Company would be furnished; that he would immediately arrange for a search to be made of these records, and any other possible records that might contain this information, the search starting this date. [redacted] stated that he would immediately advise the result of this search, and would contact the FBI no later than 3:00pm today to advise the progress that had been made.
