At approximately 8:55 a.m., 11/27/63, Inspector DON MOORE of the Bureau called and advised that Asst. Director WILLIAM SULLIVAN has a friend in New Orleans named [REDACTED] who advised SULLIVAN yesterday and a Cuban named MANUEL GIL, 620 Gravier St., New Orleans, supposedly knows OSWALD and OSWALD supposedly called GIL on the telephone.

Inspector MOORE stated GIL should be interviewed for any information he has concerning OSWALD and that they be advised by phone or teletype today of results.

I advised Mr. MOORE that one of the persons listed in the group obtaining tourists cards for travel to Mexico is from Italy and MOORE said to just forget his name.

MOORE was advised that we know OSWALD was in New Orleans on 9/17 as he checked in at the Unemployment Bureau and signed request for unemployment check, which check, according to employee at the Unemployment Bureau, would be mailed two or three days later, and it would seem OSWALD would be here to get the check.
