RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That the attached All SACs and All Legal Attachés airtel be approved, advising a copy of the report will be sent them under separate cover and instructing how to handle inquiries upon receipt,
2. Upon approval of the above, that the Administrative Division make appropriate arrangements to disseminate the reports as indicated above,
3. That the Administrative Division make similar dissemination of subsequent volumes of the report when available.
4. That the Files and Communications Division thoroughly index the Commission's report and subsequent volumes relating thereto, when received.
