Order date of Larch 5, DEA wrote me about an FHI referral with such indef initeness I have no idea what they are talking about. Their number is DEA-81-185-F.

The does not state that any balancing test was made, that the stated policy of narders possible disclosure was followed, that administrative discretion is not appropriate, even that what it withholds is not within the public dosein. There also is no claim that nothing is reaconably segregable.

I accuse that this matter is within the field office JFK case and that when DEA says the tapes involved have been processed, they have been, whatever form that processing may have taken.

It may well be that the Bill claims are proper. I don't know. I do know that when one receives the kind of letter DEA sent me one has no choice but to appeal. If they can't even identify the records, and the Fill does give them serial and file numbers, at the very least they are parencidally over-secretive.
