Dear Don,

Enclosed for your file and information are copies of my yesterday's letter to FBI FOIPA and its 3/1/84 letter to me.

These further reflect the deliberateness of FBI noncompliance with FOIA, the means by which it escalates costs and then weeps to the Congress about the wastes it has created, and a new twist in appeals: for the appeals office, having received appeals from FBI withholdings, refers the appeals back to the FBI.

As a matter of fact and undisputed court record, the FBI forced and then stonewalled all my litigation. Thus all of the litigating costs charged to FOIA are false costs, deliberately created by the FBI to deceive and mislead the Congress.

What I have sent you actually understates the reality.
