DOCTORS REPO

Turn May Have Saved Life Full Recovery Likely

DALLAS, Nov. 23-Gov. John B. Connally Jr. was reported in good condition today with a bullet wound suffered immediately after President Kennedy was assassinated.

Physicians said that the 46year-old Governor of Texas was expected to suffer no disabiling after-effects. He will remain in the hospital for 10 to 14 days.

Governor and Mrs. Connally were riding in the seat ahead of President and Mas. Kennedy vesterday when a sniper's nu-let struck the President in be-head. The Governor had turned to see what had happened when he was struck in the back by

another bullet.

Dr. Tom Shires, chief of surgeons at the University of Texas, Southwestern Medical School, said the Governor prob-ably would have been killed, it he had not turned.

"After consulting with Mrs. Connally and others on the scene," Dr. Shires said, "the consensus is that the Governor was quite fortunate that he turned see what happened to the President, If he had not turned to his right, there is a good chance he probably would have been shot through the heart. As it was, the builet caused a tan-gential wound."

Parkland Hospital reported late today that Governor Con-nally's condition was good. It

"His mental condition is clear, He is in control of all his faculties. The last X-ray of his chest

was good. We are pleased with his improved progress."
From his hospital bed, the Governor proclaimed Monday, the day of the President's functional, as "an official day mourning in Texas."

his 17-year-old son, John B. Con-nally 3d, to represent him at President Kennedy's funeral.

Physicians said that the buihad traveled through Governor's body and had broken right wrist, causing a comis left thigh. A fragment from the rib punctured his lung.

Governor Connally had tempted to persuade Presiden Kennedy to cancel his trip to Texas. It was said that the Governor had thought the Preident's trip would widen th split among Texas Democati and that he had also feared at embarrassing incident while the President was in the state
