He called them by their first names. They referred to him as Jack Ruby, the name he used while operating a striptease club.

When Assistant Dist. Atty. William F. Alexander entered the room where officers were questioning him, Rubenstein looked up and said "Hi, Bill."

Detectives said Rubenstein was breathing heavily after he was subdued and was obviously agitated. But, they said, he made a strong effort to control himself.

Investigators were impressed by his courtesy.

When Justice of the Peace Pierce McBride notified him he had been charged with murder and advised him of his rights, the slayer replied, "I'm familiar with them, but thank you for telling me."
