LANE SUGGESTS SUIT BY OSWALD'S MOTHER

Totallas, Jan. 2—A New York Imese Totallas, Jan. 2—A New York lawyer suggested today to Mrs. Marguerite Oswald that she sue the city of Dallas for the death of her son.

Mrs. Oswald, the mother of Lee H. Oswald, said that she was considering the suit, proposed by Mark Lane, a former New York State Assemblyman Mr. Lane arrived in Dallas Dec 31 to question members to Oswald's family. Oswald the accused assassin of President Kenredy, was himself shot to death by Jack Ruby, a niccub operator, while in policicustody.

Mr. Lane met for two hours with Mrs. Oswald today, tape recording her recollections of the period in late Novembe when she was under the price tion of the Secret Service.

He told her that he could retaically represent her in a suit against the city, since he had proposed the action. But he said that he had contacted a Dallas law firm that was willing to take her case.

Mr. Lare, who has written a defense brief for Oswald stressed that the suit would not be aimed principally at collecting a damages payment.
