## Oswald Mother Says She'll Tell of 'Third Life'

FT. WORTH, Tex (UPI)— The mother of Lee Harvey Oswald said Friday that she will give the Warren Commission "some facts that have never been made public" about the assassination of President John F. Kennedy when she testifies Monday.

"I have some trump cards," Mrs. Marguerite Oswald said. "I will tell the commission about Lee's life, my life and a third life."

When asked at a news conference about the "third life," Mrs. Oswald replied: "Don't ask me any more questions."

"Thrilled to Death" Mrs. Oswald, whose late son was accused of assassinating Mr. Kennedy in Dallas Nov, 22, said she is "thrilled to death to have finally broken through" with demands to appear before the commission in Washington.

"It was a real fight," she said of efforts which included sending telegrams to President Johnson and Chief Justice Earl Warren and stating her case at several news conferences. Mrs. Oswald, 56, said she is not certain her son, 24, killed the President and wants a chance to defend him before

the commission. The commission has manted her request to ap-

joint an attorney for her.
