

# Oswald Mother Says She'll Tell of 'Third Life'

FT. WORTH, Tex (UPI)—  
The mother of Lee Harvey  
Oswald said Friday that she  
will give the Warren Com-  
mission "some facts that  
have never been made pub-  
lic" about the assassination  
of President John F. Kenne-  
dy when she testifies Mon-  
day.

"I have some trump  
cards," Mrs. Marguerite Os-  
wald said. "I will tell the  
commission about Lee's life,  
my life and a third life."

When asked at a news  
conference about the "third  
life," Mrs. Oswald replied:  
"Don't ask me any more  
questions."

## 'Thrilled to Death'

Mrs. Oswald, whose late  
son was accused of assassin-  
ating Mr. Kennedy in Dallas  
Nov. 22, said she is "thrilled  
to death to have finally  
broken through" with de-  
mands to appear before the  
commission in Washington.

"It was a real fight," she  
said of efforts which includ-  
ed sending telegrams to  
President Johnson and Chief  
Justice Earl Warren and  
stating her case at several  
news conferences.

Mrs. Oswald, 56, said she is  
not certain her son, 24, killed  
the President and wants a  
chance to defend him before  
the commission.

The commission has  
granted her request to ap-  
point an attorney for her.
