

Rifle Used on Walker, Kennedy Believed Same

DALLAS (AP)—The mail-order rifle which was believed to have killed President John F. Kennedy was the same used in the attack on former Gen. Edwin Walker, a Dallas police ballistics test report indicated Tuesday.

The report was made public by Chief Jesse Curry and Chief of Detectives M. W. Stevenson.

Stevenson said points of comparison of the slug which missed Gen. Walker match fragments of the bullets which took the President's life.

"The ballistics report cannot be final or conclusive," Stevenson said, "but generally the comparison points of the slugs were good."

Lee Harvey Oswald's wife told FBI agents that her husband came home one night and blurted to her that he had killed the controversial former Army leader.
