

2 Witnesses Reported in Assassination

DALLAS (AP)—The Dallas Times Herald said Monday it has learned that two heretofore undisclosed witnesses saw a man in the sixth-floor window of the building from which President John F. Kennedy was assassinated Nov. 22.

The newspaper said a teen-age boy and a construction worker saw the man while they were standing in the street when the fatal shots were fired from the Texas Book Depository Building.

Lee Harvey Oswald was charged with the President's death later, but the Times Herald said the two failed to identify him as the man in the window after viewing him in a police lineup.

The newspaper said "qualified sources" knew of the two witnesses, but neither was named.
